**BLUE HILL/BROADACRES GOLF COURSE
2011 RESIDENT PERMIT INFORMATION**

Resident permits are available to individuals who reside (live) within the boundaries of the Town of Orangetown. The purpose of the permit is to identify Orangetown residents to golf course personnel. The benefits of this permit are as follows: Greensfee rate discounts, advantages for preferred tee times for weekdays and weekends and senior citizen and youth discount programs. For the safety of all golfers, it is the responsibility of the permit holder to be familiar with the rules and etiquette of the game of golf. Failure to follow these rules can result in permit revocation and suspension of playing privileges.

*All players must present their current permit at the Pro Shop each and every time they play. All permits issued in the year 2010 expire on March 31, 2011.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURES:

Permits must be obtained for all resident golfers in 2011. Permits will be available at the Parks and Recreation Office, located at Veteran's Memorial Park, 81 Hunt Road, Orangeburg, at the following times:

Permit Registration Schedule: March 7th thru May 21st
Monday: 3:00pm – 7:00pm
Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday: 10:00am – 4:00pm
Saturday 9:00am – 12:00 noon
Beginning Monday, May 23rd, Monday thru Friday, 10:00am-4:00pm ONLY!

The following proofs of residency are necessary at time of permit registration (must show name and current address):

- Valid New York State Photo Driver's License or other Photo ID with address. Non-drivers can show Passports, but must provide three additional items with current address.

AND TWO OF THE FOLLOWING TYPES OF PROOF:

2010 W-2 Tax Form, Current property tax bill, rental agreement showing residence, voter registration card, credit card bill, utility bill, cable TV bill, and current vehicle registration and insurance card may count as one.

****TOTAL OF THREE PROOFS MUST BE PRESENTED FOR PERMIT!!**
(Youth w/ parents must provide one proof, such as school ID or recent report card)

WEEKDAYS and WEEKENDS:

- Registered Orangetown Residents – Eight (8) days in advance.
- Associate/Corporate Members – Five (5) days in advance.
- Non-Residents – Three (3) days in advance. (Non-residents will not have access to the Teletrac System)
- The automated tee time system will permit bookings beginning at 12:00a.m. as per the days stated above.

Making Reservations Online: Current permit holders will continue to use their established user I.D. and password for the automated tee time reservation system. New permit holders will use their *household I.D.number* as their login and their last name as their *password*. They will have the ability to change their password the first time they use the system.

Making Reservations through TeleTrac: Only resident, associate or corporate members will be able to utilize the automated phone system. They will use their nine (9) digit permit number located on the back of their key FOB as their login number.

General Rules:

Tee-times must be made for two (2), three (3) or four (4) golfers. Singles players will secure tee times through the Pro Shop. Phone reservations (not automated) can be made no earlier than one (1) day in advance.

Only one tee-time reservation can be accepted per internet inquiry.

Course management will continue to book tee-times for both tournament and league play.

Tee times will not be permitted in the automated system beginning at 11:59 p.m. one day prior to the day of play.

(Example: The system will not accept tee times for Saturday after 11:59 p.m. on Thursday).

Golfers will be permitted no more than two (2) tee times per day, provided they are no less than 6 hours apart.

No-Show/Cancellation Policy: All cancellations must be made through the Pro Shop by 11:50 p.m. one day prior to the day of play. (Example: The system will not accept tee time for Saturday after 11:59 p.m. on Thursday). Repeated no shows without cancellation could result in a revocation of system access.

Miscellaneous: Please note, when booking tee times through the automated system for Blue Hill Golf Course, you will be asked to select a starting course. You will choose between Pines, Woodlands or Lakeside. Course staff will make every effort to honor this request; however, your starting location may change due to course conditions.

WEEKEND SEASONAL STARTING TIMES: Reservations for the weekend seasonal time program may be obtained by completing the seasonal application offered for the following: **FULL SEASON (20 Weeks)** OR **HALF SEASON (10 Weeks)**. These programs are open to **Orangetown resident permit holders**. Associate permit holders will have access once all residents have been accommodated. Guests may participate as substitutes upon approval by management.

1) Weekend seasonal starting times are: 20-Weeks (Full Season): \$2960.00 Per Foursome (\$740.00 per player), and 10-Weeks (A or B Half Season): \$1480.00 Per Foursome (\$370.00 per player). This rate includes a \$3.00 per round reservation fee. All seasonal fees shall be paid up-front to reserve the time. (See enclosed schedule)

2) These seasonal times are prepaid and will be assigned based on **PRIOR 2010** season performance and foursome commitments. New groups will be assigned on a space available basis.

3) **There will be NO REFUNDS in this program. Further, there will be no refunds due to weather conditions unless the course is officially closed.** This is a weekend program for permit holders. Non-Permit holder substitutions are accepted with prior approval. All guests will be charged the additional seasonal alternate rate, and notification must be given in advance to the Pro Shop for any guest substitutions.

Non-compliance with these regulations can result in full suspension of all golf privileges and greensfees.

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS:

- 1) Seasonal Weekend Program is limited to 2011 Orangetown Permit Holders ONLY. Upon registration, groups consisting of four (4) Resident members or three (3) Resident members and one (1) Associate member will be permitted.
- 2) Associate members or non-members can be used as alternate substitutes for Resident members and Associate members, however a ratio of three (3) resident members to one (1) non-member or three (3) Resident members to one (1) Associate member is required at the time of play. Notification and approval in advance must be given for any non-resident/associate substitution. Alternate substitutes must pay an additional fee of \$34.00 for Non Residents and \$29.00 for Associate Members. This payment must occur at the Pro Shop, and the alternate must present his receipt from the Pro Shop to the starter before play.
- 3) 2011 Permit Holders may only hold one (1) seasonal starting time during the course of the season; however a seasonal starting time holder may substitute on another day.
- 4) Seasonal dates may be canceled due to family or business commitments, by notifying the Pro Shop one (1) week in advance of the date change. All seasonal time holders MUST notify the Pro Shop in advance of any available openings due to illness to receive seasonal credit.
