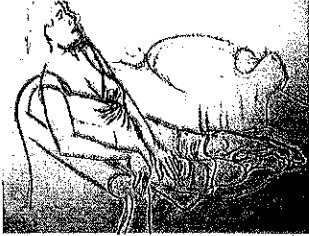
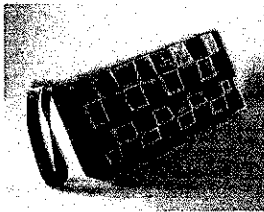


Figure Drawing for Pre-Teens and Teens
