

NOTICE OF ANNUAL ELECTION
CENTRAL NYACK FIRE DISTRICT

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Annual Election of the Central Nyack Fire District will take place on December 9, 2014, between the hours of 6:00 P.M. and 9:00 P.M. at the firehouse located at 43 Waldron Avenue, Central Nyack, New York, for the following purposes:

To elect one (1) Fire District Commissioner for a five (5) year term commencing January 1, 2015 and ending December 31, 2019; and

To elect one (1) Fire District Treasurer for a three (3) year term commencing January 1, 2015 and ending December 31, 2017; and

To vote upon the following proposition:

Board resolution of the Central Nyack Fire District, in the Towns of Clarkstown and Orangetown, New York adopted September 9, 2014 which reads as follows:

“RESOLVED, THAT PURSUANT TO SECTION 6—G OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL LAW, AS AMENDED, THE CENTRAL NYACK FIRE DISTRICT DOES HEREBY ESTABLISH A CAPITAL RESERVE FUND TO FINANCE THE COST OF CONSTRUCTION, RECONSTRUCTION, ACQUISITION OF LAND AND FOR ALL COSTS ASSOCIATED THEREWITH.

THE FIRE DISTRICT TREASURER IS HEREBY DIRECTED TO DEPOSIT MONEYS OF THIS RESERVE FUND IN A SEPARATE BANK ACCOUNT TO BE KNOWN AS THE “LAND RESERVE FUND.”

THE FIRE DISTRICT TREASURER IS AUTHORIZED TO INVEST, FROM TIME TO TIME, THE MONEYS OF THIS FUND PURSUANT TO SECTION 6—F OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL LAW.

NO EXPENDITURE SHALL BE MADE FROM THIS FUND, EXCEPT UPON AUTHORIZATION OF THIS BOARD PURSUANT TO A PERMISSIVE REFERENDUM.”

Be approved?

All residents of the Central Nyack Fire District, who are duly registered to vote with the Rockland County Board of Elections on or before November 17, 2014 shall be entitled to vote at this election.

Any person desiring to have his or her name appear on the ballot for one of the above offices must have filed a written request, specifying the office by term expiration date for which the name should appear, with the Secretary of the Fire District not later than November 19, 2014.
