HABR#07-20: Application of Jeffrey Croyle for review of a replacement roof at an existing single-family residence located at 265Kings Highway, in the Town of Orangetown, Hamlet of Tappan, New York. Chapter 12, Section 12-4 (A), Historic Areas Board of Review.

Tax Numbers: 77.07 / 2 / 37; R-15 zoning district.

Heard by the HISTORIC AREAS BOARD OF REVIEW at a meeting held on Tuesday, November 13, 2007 at which time the Board made the following determination:

John Deans appeared and testified.

The applicant presented the following:

- 1. Survey dated October 22, 2001.
- 2. Three pictures.

John Deans stated that he is representing Jeff Croyle; that the older part of the roof needs to be repaired; that they are planning on using cedar shingles; that an ice shield would be placed behind the shingles to let air through' that the shingles would have a $5\frac{1}{2}$ " exp0osure; that the original part of the house was built in the 1800's; and that some areas of the roof may need to have the plywood replaced.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

No public comment.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

The Board, after personal observation of the property, hearing all the testimony and reviewing same, found as fact, that:

1. The application as presented would not adversely affect the Historic District and the surrounding area. The design and materials for the proposed roof are complimentary to the District.

DECISION: In view of the foregoing and the testimony before the Board, the application is APPROVED as submitted and presented with the following conditions:

- 1. The roof shingles shall be 18" taper-sawn Western Red cedar shingles installed at a 5 ½" exposure using a stainless steel ring shank fastener.
- 2. Some areas of the roof may need ½' plywood.
- 3. A new lead coated copper step flashing where roof meets side wall.
