ORDER CALLING
PUBLIC HEARING

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Orangetown, Rockland County, New York, has duly caused to be prepared a map showing the boundaries of a proposed sewer district in said Town, to be known as the Orangetown Sewer District in the Town of Orangetown (hereinafter, the "Sewer District" or simply, the "District") a general plan to serve said District, and a report of the proposed method of operation thereof, and

WHEREAS, said map, plan and report dated July 2005 included an estimate of the cost of such District at \$22,100,000 and was prepared by Ronald Delo, P.E., a competent engineer duly licensed by the State of New York, and filed in the office of the Town Clerk of said Town; and

WHEREAS, an amended map, plan and report dated March 2006 was approved to cover scope modifications at a new maximum estimated cost of \$34,900,000; and

WHEREAS, as a result of cost increases, it was necessary to increase the maximum estimated cost by \$12,022,000 to a new maximum estimated cost of \$46,922,000; and

WHEREAS, as a result of additional cost increases, it is necessary to increase the maximum estimated cost by \$3,000,000 to a new maximum estimated cost of \$49,922,000; and

WHEREAS, the improvements proposed for said District consist of various improvements to the wastewater treatment plant, pumping stations, sewer mains and buildings, including, original furnishings, equipment, machinery, apparatus, appurtenances, and incidental improvements and expenses in connection therewith, all as more fully described in the amended map, plan and report; and

WHEREAS, the proposed method of financing the cost of said improvements consists of the issuance of \$49,922,000 serial bonds of said Town maturing in annual installments over a period not exceeding forty years, which will be payable in the first instance from the assessments from the several lots and parcels of land within said District in the manner provided by law in an amount sufficient to pay the principal and interest on said bonds as the same become due, but if not paid from such source, all the taxable real property in said Town shall be subject to the levy of ad valorem taxes without limitation as to rate or amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on said bonds as the same shall become due and payable; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of hook-up fees to the typical property and a two family home in said District is \$200; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of said District to the typical property therein is \$310.23 in the first year in which operation, maintenance, debt service and other charges and expenses are to be paid (including \$5.87 for new debt) and \$488.80 to a two family home (including \$6.18 for new debt); and

WHEREAS, a detailed explanation of the manner by which were computed said estimated costs of hook-up fees and first-year costs to the typical property has been filed in the office of the Town Clerk where the same are available during regular office hours for examination by any person interested in the subject manner thereof; and

WHEREAS, it is now desired to call a public hearing upon the question of the increased cost of the establishment of said District and the improvements proposed therefor, all pursuant to Section 209-h of the Town Law; NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

ORDERED, by the Town Board of the Town of Orangetown, Rockland County, New York, as follows:

Section 1. A meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Orangetown, Rockland County, New York, shall be held at the Town Hall, in Orangetown, New York, in said Town, on the 26th day of ~~December~~^{January, 2010} ~~2009~~, at 8:30 o'clock P.M., Prevailing Time, for the purpose of holding a public hearing to consider the increased cost of establishment of the Orangetown Sewer District in said Town as described in the preambles hereof, and the improvements proposed therefor, and to consider the amended map, plan and report filed in relation thereto, and to hear all persons interested in the subject matter thereof concerning the same, and for such other action on the part of said Town Board as may be required by law or shall be proper in the premises.

Section 2.
