

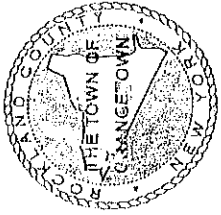

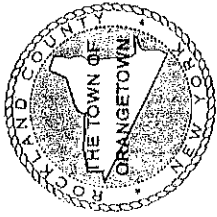

Their references were checked and found to be satisfactory.

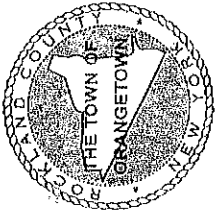

RE: Tier II & III Pumping Station Improvements Phase II

As of last bid for this project the apparent low bidder was RLJ Construction in the amount of \$385,620. Further investigating the qualifications of RLJ, it was discovered that they are not holders of a Master Electrical License in Rockland County, which according to local law deems them unable to participate in this project. Chris Mandler, President of RLJ Construction sent a signed statement dated April 20, 2010 formally withdrawing his bid for the reason mentioned above.

The next lowest qualified bidder is Valentine Electric, Inc. in the amount of \$447,065. They completed all required bid documents. I checked into some of their past construction projects and those who responded had positive comments and stated they would recommend Valentine Electric. In regards to related work experience, Valentine Electric does not appear to have worked on municipal wastewater projects before nor has shown indication they have wired wastewater pumps or VFD's. But they have engaged in projects of similar contract amounts, mostly comprised of large commercial facilities.

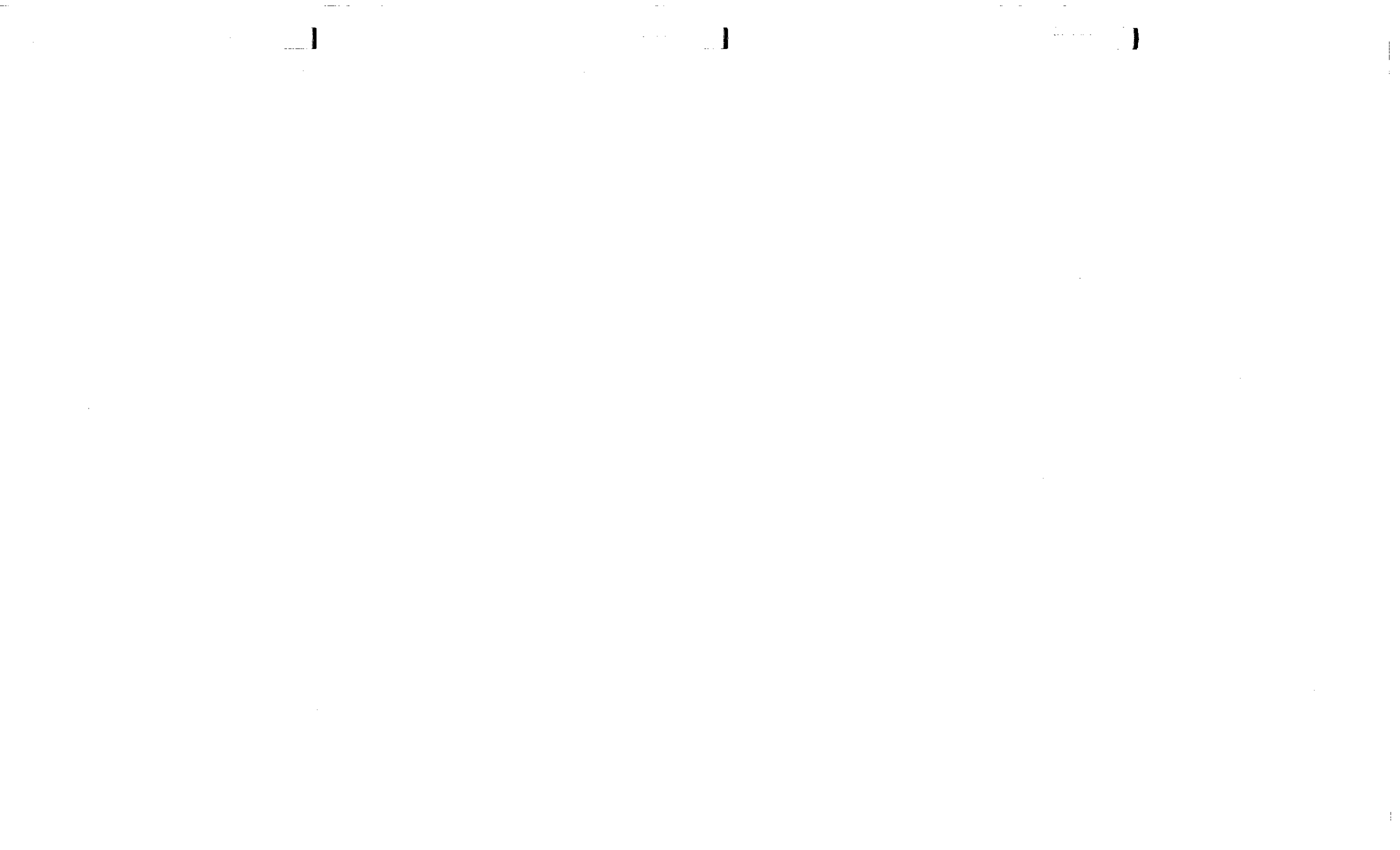


