

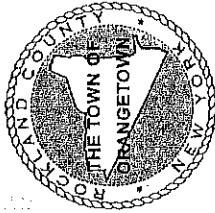

References were checked for this company and found to be satisfactory.

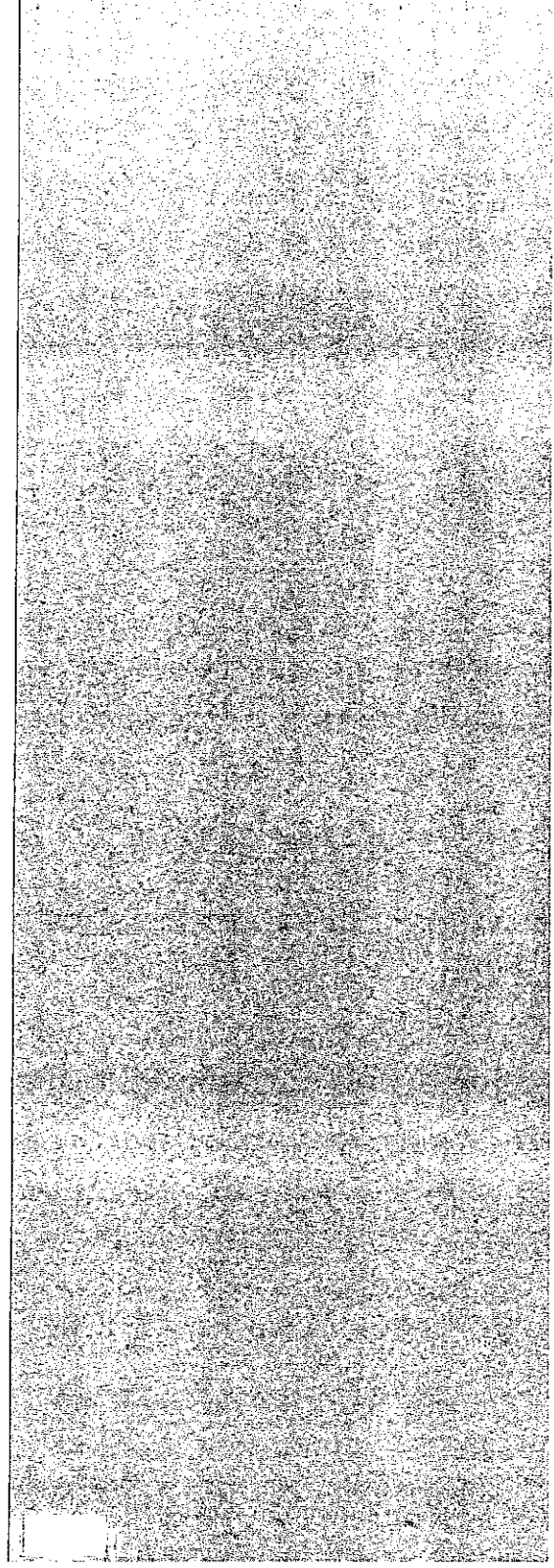
For your information, three companies had picked up the bid package for this project and several others were forwarded directly the Notice to Bidders.



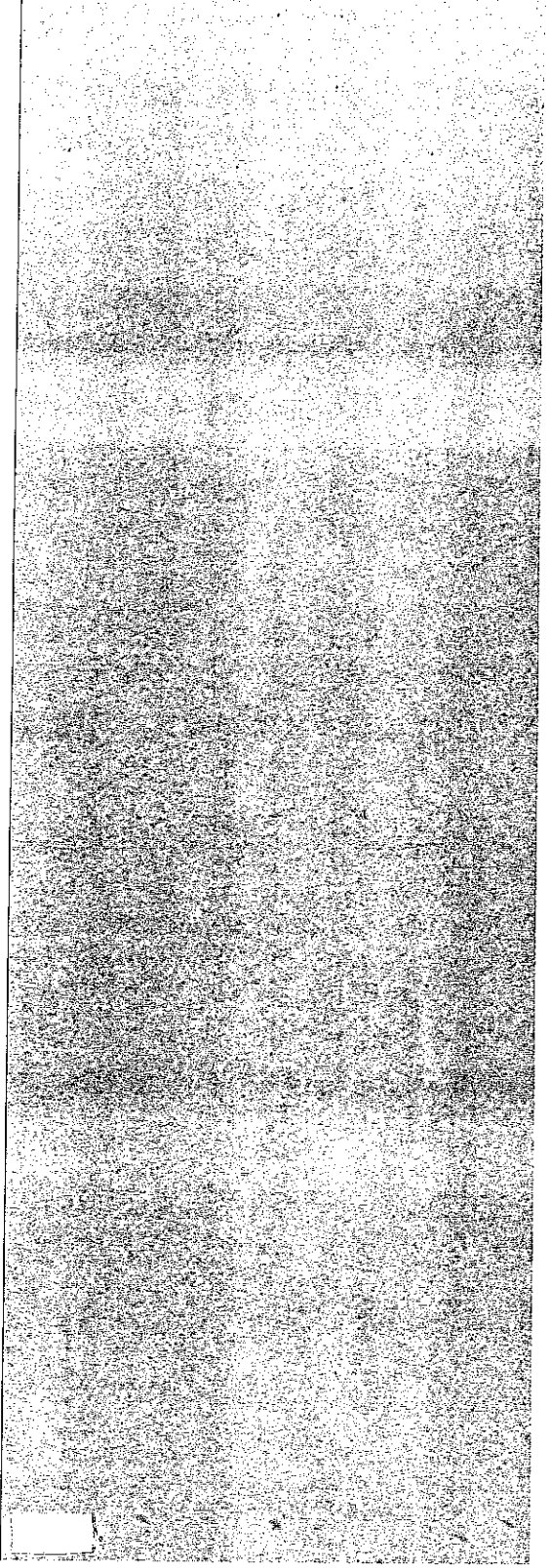
