



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, pursuant to resolution of the Town Board of the Town of Orangetown, duly adopted on May 12, 2015, a public hearing will be held before the Town Board at the Orangetown Town Hall, 26 Orangeburg Road, Orangeburg, New York 10962, on the 16th day of June at 8:00 P.M., to consider the adoption of a Local Law, amending Chapter 43, § 4.4 of the Town Code of the Town of Orangetown, entitled "Prohibited Uses", to list additional uses, materials and processes within the scope of the Chapter, including "solvents and similar such materials, including benzene, toluene, xylene" to the § 4.41 listing of prohibited manufacturing uses which involve the primary production of such items from raw materials. The proposed amendment would further prohibit waste gasification as a process Town-wide.
