It is recommended that the above noted bid be awarded to American Wear Uniforms, East Orange, New Jersey, at a price of \$1.94 per employee, per week, the only qualified bidder. For your information, there was a reduction in price of \$.84 per employee, per week, compared to the previous 2-year contract.

This bid was advertised in the Town's official newspapers as well as being advertised through the Hudson Valley Municipal Purchasing Group.

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
