

A LOCAL LAW AMENDING CHAPTER 34 ENTITLED "TAXATION"

BE IT ENACTED, that the Town Board of the Town of Orangetown after a Public Hearing held on the 6th day of November, 2006, adopted Local Law No. 16, 2006, amending Local Law No. 10, 1983 (Chapter 34 of the Code of the Town of Orangetown entitled "Taxation) as follows:

1. Amend Section 34-3(D)(2) by amending the annual income schedule as follows:

**LOCAL LAW NO. _____, 2006
OF THE TOWN OF ORANGETOWN**

**A LOCAL LAW AMENDING LOCAL LAW NO. 3, 1964 (CHAPTER 39 OF THE
CODE OF THE TOWN OF ORANGETOWN ENTITLED "VEHICLES AND
TRAFFIC").**

Be it enacted by the Town Council of the Town of Orangetown that the Local Law No. 3, 1964 (Chapter 39 of the Code of the Town of Orangetown entitled "Vehicles and Traffic") adopted on December 9, 1964, as amended, be and hereby is amended by this Local Law No. _____, 2006, so as to **add** a new sub-section "3" to paragraph "L" of §39-5, as follows:

§ 39-5. Prohibition of stopping, standing or parking in specified places.

L. In the Hamlet of Tappan:

- (3) No parking on the north side of Old Tappan Road, east and west of the entrance to the building commonly known as the "Manse Barn" for a distance of thirty-five feet (35').

This Local Law No. _____, 2006, shall take effect immediately upon filing in the Office of the Secretary of State in accordance with §27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.






