- 1. The Board found that during construction, the applicant had field changes that differed from the approved site and house plans.
 - a. The approved plans note shutters on the front façade, however, no shutters were placed on the entire house.
 - b. The air conditioning unit was moved from the approved location to the northeast corner of the house to make it easier to hide in a mulched bed of shrubs.
 - c. Retaining walls were moved in order to accommodate an improved site plan. The same materials for the retaining walls were used as approved under ACABOR #17-38.
 - d. The deck was relocated and increased in size. The same materials for the deck were used as approved under ACABOR #17-38.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

- 1. The Board found that the applicant requested approval for the construction of a deck to be added to the Grill Room section of the existing building. The Foundation would match the existing stone work on the structure; greyish/black natural tone in square shapes of various sizes. The railings would match in color and shape to an existing deck at the site, aluminum railings, Trax, or equal, in grey/natural color.
- 2. The Board found that the applicant proposed no new landscaping, however two small trees would need to be removed for construction of the deck.
- 3. The Board found that the applicant and Board had a discussion regarding the type of steel material that would be used and recommended using Galvanized steel. If the applicant painted the steel, it would be hard to maintain.
