The siding would consist of Hardi Plank Lap Siding, Hardi Shingle Siding and Hardi Board Batten Siding, all in white, or equal. The roof material would be Architectural Roof Shingles in Charcoal Grey and metal standing seam roof in black, or equal. Natural stone veneer in gray color would be placed along the front foundation and wrap around the house to the rear elevation, as noted on the plan.
