FINDINGS OF FACT:

- 1. The Board found that the applicant proposed to install two signs;
 - Monument sign mounted to a brick wall structure in the same brick color as the main building. The sign would have silver color trim and lettering to match the main building at 100 Corporate Drive.
 - Directional sign to feature a dark gray finish with blue paneling and silver trim. The proposed directional sign would be a fabricated aluminum sign with reflective vinyl graphics. The directional sign matches the other Hudson Crossing signs the Board had previously approved.
- 2. The Board found that the new monument sign would be lit with flood lights from ground mounted up lighting. Landscaping would be planted around the signed, as noted on the submitted landscaping plan; 5 evergreen shrubs and seasonal plantings.
- 3. The Board found that the existing billboard located on the front of the property would be removed.
- 4. The Board found that the applicant needed to appear in front of the Town of Orangetown Zoning Board of Appeals for the needed variances. If the design changed, the applicant would return to ACABOR for reapproval.

The hearing was then opened to the Public. There being no one to be heard from the public, the Public Hearing portion of the meeting was closed.

DECISION: In view of the foregoing and the testimony before the Board, the application was Approved as Presented.
