FINDINGS OF FACT:

- 1. The Board found that the applicant proposed to construct a 35,400 square foot addition to the rear of an existing building. There would be an outdoor storage area used for assembly and staging of equipment. An attractive aluminum screen wall would be designed to match the building façade to shield the view of the outdoor staging area from the road and adjoining property.
- 2. The Board found that the façade consisted of materials that matched the existing façade; split face white concrete block base, corrugated metal siding and a white standing seam metal roof. Lighting would-be low-level safety lighting around the structure.

The hearing was then opened to the Public. There being no one to be heard from the public, the Public Hearing portion of the meeting was closed.

DECISION: In view of the foregoing and the testimony before the Board, the application was Approved as Presented.
