RE: 656 Oak Tree Road Plans: The application of Comito Homes, owner, for Review of Site/Landscaping Plans at a site to be known as "656 Oak Tree Road Plans", located in the Palisades Historic District, in accordance with Article 16 of the Town Law of the State of New York and Chapter 2 of the Code of the Town of Orangetown. The site is located at 656 Oak Tree Road, Palisades, Town of Orangetown, Rockland County, New York, and as shown on the Orangetown Tax Map as Section 78.17, Block 2, Lot 9 in the R-40 zoning district.

Heard by the Architecture and Community Appearance Board of Review of the Town of Orangetown at a meeting held **Thursday, March 3, 2022**, at which time the Board made the following determinations:

Jay Greenwell, Marc Comito and George Palladine appeared and testified. The Board received the following items:

- **A.** Site Plan prepared by Jay Greenwell, PLS, dated October 7, 2021, last revised January 27, 2022.
- **B.** Landscape Plan prepared by Blythe Yost, Landscape Architect, dated January 28, 2022.
- C. Material Specification Sheet and Project Narrative prepared by Applicant dated February 4, 2022.
- **D.** A copy of the Building Permit Referral dated January 11, 2021 prepared by Rick Oliver, Deputy Building Inspector.

## FINDINGS OF FACT:

- The Board found that the site is located in the Palisades Historic District. The Town of Orangetown Historic Areas Board will review the house design and ACABOR will review the site and landscaping plans.
- 2. The Board found that the applicant will plant approximately 90 trees in order to screen the house foundation. The screening on site will include at least 10 Norway Spruce Trees.
- 3. The Board found that the site was a narrow lot and the applicant has tried to screen the new development as much as possible.

- 4. The Board found that the exterior air conditioning unit would be placed on the west elevation, screened with plantings, as noted on the submitted landscape plan.
- 5. Trees to be saved shall be protected with snow fencing to the drip line during construction
- 6. No grading is to take place within five feet of any property line, except as specified on the approved site plan.

The hearing was then opened to the Public.

**Public Comment:** 

Greg Kraus, 520 Oak Tree Road, an abutting property owner, wanted to know which trees would be removed and requested the applicant to meet with him. Mr. Kraus was concerned about the location of his property line and how the new development would impact his property.

There being no one else to be heard from the public, the Public Hearing portion of the meeting was closed.
