Larry Bucciarelli asked where the generator would be installed; and if it could be seen from the street.

Christopher Andrianos answered that there was a picture submitted and the generator will be on the side of the house with landscaping, some boxwoods and PJM's; and that it would not be visible from the road because the property is heavily landscaped.
