The roof shingle would be GAF architectural shingles, or equal, to match the existing style and color of the house. The siding would be painted wood to match the existing and trim painted to match the existing house, the color scheme would be light blue and yellow.

1. The Board found that the applicant proposed to replace an existing glass entrance to the building with a new wall system featuring full height glass curtain walls with tinted insulated glass and aluminum tubes as well as portions of metal stud framed walls with aluminum metal panel cladding. The upgraded curtain wall system and aluminum panel design will introduce a more contemporary look to the building's entrance area and exhibit a more attractive aesthetic for prospective tenants and visitors.
