HABR#23-01: Application of Ginger Zee for review of Solar Panels at a proposed single-family residence. The premises are located at 7 Kopac Lane, Palisades, New York. Chapter 12 of the Code of the Town of Orangetown, Section 12-4 (A), Historical Areas Board of Review. Tax Map Designation: 78.13 / 1 / 3.13; R-40 zoning district.

Heard by the HISTORICAL AREAS BOARD OF REVIEW at a meeting held on Tuesday, January 10, 2023 at which time the Board made the following determination:

Emily Quiroa, Sunpower, appeared.

The following documents were presented:

- 1. Plans labeled "Solar Individual Permit Package Ginger Zee/Ben Colonomos" (4pages) signed and sealed by Paymon Eskandanian, P.E.
- 2. Color rendering of the house showing the placement of the proposed panels with neighboring houses. (6 pages)

Emily Quiroa, from Sunpower, representing the applicant, stated hat the solar panels are a 13.70 grid system with 33 solar panels on the south side of the house, which gets the most sun; that the railings are on the roof and under the panels; that they are black and they will save the applicant money on the utility bills.

Loren Plotkin asked questions about how the panels are installed and the colors

Larry Bucciarelli stated that the meter spins backward and credits the applicant.

- 1. The solar panels are black and glass, 13.70 grid system.
- 2. There shall be 33 panels installed on the back, right side and front of the house, all of which get southern exposure.
