Carol Dolan stated that she is the 7th owner of her house; that the area that she would like to replace the windows use to be a sunroom; that she is proposing the same size windows but instead of opening up and down, the new windows would be sliders; that they would be a sandy color on the outside, which would match the house and they would be wood inside and she plans to stain them chestnut to match the rest of the interior wood; and that the area in question would be where there are four windows and that would be replaced with three windows, a solid window in the middle and opening windows on either side.

William Walther asked about how the sliders worked.
