### PROPOSED LOCAL LAW # \_\_\_\_ - 2023

### A LOCAL LAW TO ADD A NEW CHAPTER TO THE TOWN TO BE ENTITLED "PUBLIC MEETINGS" AND IDENTIFIED AS CHAPTER 26, TO PERMIT ATTENDANCE BY ME-MEMBERS OF PUBLIC BODIES OF TOWN GOVERNMENT TO ATTEND PUBLIC MEET-INGS VIA VIDEOCONFERENCING UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Orangetown as follows: The Code of the Town of Orangetown, shall be amended to incorporate revisions as described:

Section 1. Title

### CHAPTER 26 Public Meetings

### Article I Videoconferencing

### § 26-1 Definitions.

Unless otherwise expressly stated, wherever used in this chapter, the following terms shall have these meanings:

### **EXECUTIVE SESSION**

The same meaning as that term has in New York Public Officers Law § 105.

### EXTRAORDINARY CIRCUMSTANCES

A disability, a hospitalization, an illness, caregiving responsibilities, exposure to a serious communicable disease, the hospitalization, death or illness of a relative or a significant or unexpected factor or event that prevents a member of a public body from being physically present at the location of such public body's meeting.

### **PUBLIC BODY**

The Town Board, the Planning Board, Zoning Board of Appeals, the Architecture and Community Board of Review, the Board of Assessment Review, the Historical Areas Board of Review, the Project Review Committee and Traffic Advisory Board.

### § 26-2 Discretion to use videoconferencing.

At its discretion, a public body may employ videoconferencing during any meeting that is required to be open to the general public pursuant to Article 7 of the New York Public Officers Law, even in the absence of a declaration of emergency, provided that a quorum of the members of the public body is present in the same physical location where members of the public can attend such meeting and such body complies with this chapter.

### § 26-3 Attendance requirement; circumstances for videoconferencing.

Members of the public body shall be physically present at the location of such meeting unless a member is unable to be physically present due to extraordinary circumstances. If the public body exercises its discretion under § 26-3 of this Chapter, a member of the public body who is not

physically present at the location of such meeting due to extraordinary circumstances may participate at such meeting and vote on any matters on which the public body votes by means of videoconferencing. The extraordinary circumstance preventing that member's physical attendance shall be announced during the meeting.

### § 26-4 Public notice of videoconferencing.

If it is contemplated that videoconferencing will be used at a meeting, the public notice for that meeting shall inform the public that videoconferencing will be used, where the public can view and/or participate in such meeting, where required documents and records will be posted or be available and identify the physical location where the public can attend the meeting. If extraordinary circumstances present themselves on an emergent basis, the public body shall update its notice as soon as practicable to update its notice to include that information, which updated notice shall be posted on the Town's website.

### § 26-5 Participation in meetings.

- A. Except in the case of executive sessions, the videoconferencing shall enable members of the public body to be heard, seen and identified while the meeting is being conducted, including those portions of the meeting where any motions, proposals, resolutions and any other matter are discussed and voted upon.
- B. Members of the public shall have the opportunity to view such meeting through video and to participate by way of videoconferencing in real time at times when public comment or participation is authorized by law or by the procedural rules of the public body in a way similar to the way members of the public who are physically present at the meeting are allowed to comment or participate at such meeting.

### § 26-6 Accessibility requirements for videoconferencing media.

The videoconferencing media shall utilize technology that permits access by members of the public with disabilities in a manner that is consistent with the 1990 Americans with Disabilities Act, as amended, and its corresponding guidelines and regulations.

### § 26-7 Minutes.

The minutes of any meeting where videoconferencing is used shall include which members participated remotely and shall be made available to the members of the public pursuant to New York Public Officers Law § 106.

### § 26-8 Recordings of videoconferenced meetings.

The public body shall provide that each meeting where videoconferencing is used be recorded and that such recording be posted or linked on the public website of the Town of Orangetown within five business days following the meeting. The recording shall not contain discussions during an executive session or during recesses to obtain advice of counsel. The recording shall remain available on the website for a minimum of five years after the meeting was adjourned. Such recordings shall be transcribed upon request at a cost to the requestor equivalent to the rate charged by a court reporter for transcribing the minutes of a trial or hearing.

### § 26-9 Compliance with written procedure requirement.

This Chapter is deemed to be the written procedures governing member and public attendance required by New York Public Officers Law § 103-a Subdivision 2(b). It shall be posted conspicuously on the Town of Orangetown's website.

### § 26-10 Exemption.

The requirement for physical presence by members of a public body contained in § 26-3 of the Code shall not apply during a state disaster emergency declared by the Governor pursuant to § 28 of the New York Executive Law, or a local state of emergency proclaimed by the County Executive of Rockland County or the Supervisor of the Town of Orangetown pursuant to § 24 of the New York Executive Law, if the public body determines that the circumstances that led to the declaration of a state disaster emergency or a local state of emergency would affect or impair the ability of the public body to conduct an in-person meeting.

### Section 2. Severability Clause

The invalidity of any word, section, clause, paragraph, sentence, part or provision of this local law shall not affect the validity of any other part of this local law that can be given effect without such invalid parts.

### Section 3. Effective Date.

This Local Law shall become effective immediately upon being filed with the Secretary of State.

### LOCAL LAW NO.\_\_\_OF 2020 OF THE INCORPORATED TOWN OF ORANGETOWN, NEW YORK TOWN BOARD TO AMEND CHAPTER 43 ARTICLE IV §4.3(O)(iii)(h) OF THE TOWN CODE WITH RESPECT TO SPECIAL PERMITS FOR MIXED USE DEVELOPMENTS

Be it enacted, by the Town Board of the Town of Orangetown as follows:

<u>Section 1.</u> Chapter 43, Article IV, Section 4.32(O)(iii)(h)) shall be amended to permit fast food restaurants. As amended, Section 4.32(O)(iii) shall read (deletions are <u>strikethrough</u>, additions are <u>underlined</u>):

### (h) Restaurants, <u>excluding including fast-food restaurants</u>. <u>The provisions of Section</u> 8.13 of the Town Code shall not apply to fast-food restaurants under this section.

<u>Section 2.</u> Severability. If any part or provision of this local law, or the application thereof to any person or circumstance, is adjudged invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall be confined in its operation to the part, provision or application directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered and shall not affect or impair the validity of the remainder of this local law, or the application thereof to other persons or circumstances. The Town Board hereby declares that it would have enacted the remainder of this local law even without any such invalid or unconstitutional part, provision or application.

Section 3. This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.

("AKRF") is pleased to present this additional work proposal (Change Order #3) to the Town of Orangetown (the "Client") to extent the Town Board's review and approval component of the Town of Orangetown Comprehensive Plan. The specific services that the consultant shall provide are set forth in the "Scope of Services". Compensation for the consultant's services is in accordance with fees presented in Table 1. Services shall be provided in accordance with the terms and conditions, of AKRF's contract with the Town of Orangetown dated May 17, 2021, as last modified by the additional work authorized for the addition public workshop on February 2, 2022.

### SCOPE OF SERVICES

### ADDITIONAL TOWN BOARD MEETINGS AND PUBLIC HEARINGS

AKRF's contract included two Town Board meetings. The draft Comprehensive Plan was referred to the Town Board on September 13, 2022, and since that time AKRF has attended five meetings (October 25, 2022, December 13, 2022, January 24, 2023, March 7, 2023, and April 11, 2023). We respectfully request that an additional \$2,500 be authorized to cover the costs associated with these additional meetings. AKRF further requests that attendance at future meetings be invoiced on an hourly basis, with an initial allowance of \$2,500. Should attendance at additional meetings be required, AKRF will seek written authorization for additional funds.

### FINALIZE THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

AKRF's contract included one round of edits following the close of the Public Hearing. AKRF provided substantive edits to the draft Comprehensive Plan on December 5, 2022, March 1, 2023, and April 25, 2023. We respectfully request that \$9,750 be authorized to cover the costs associated with the additional rounds of edits already completed. AKRF further requests that future edits be invoiced on an hourly basis, with an initial allowance of \$5,000. Should additional edits be required, AKRF will seek written authorization for additional funds.

### FEE SCHEDULE

The scope of services would be completed as presented in Table 1. Direct printing and mailing expenses would be billed at-cost in accordance with AKRF's contract with the Town of Orangetown.

As part of the organizational and permit process, we are working with all agencies and jurisdictions along the GFNY course, which usually include: PANYNJ, NJ DOT, NYS DOT, Palisades Interstate Park Commission, Harriman State Park, Rockland County, Fort Lee, Englewood Cliffs, Edgewater, Alpine, every town in Rockland County: Orangetown, Clarkstown, Haverstraw, Ramapo and Stony Point and many Rockland County Villages. We will provide the Town of Orangetown with a Certificate of Insurance in March 2023.

### **Orangetown Police at GFNY**

GFNY requests assistance from Orangetown Police to control traffic to enable the cyclists to ride on a traffic-moderated course for May 21, 2023. We plan a similar route to GFNY 2022. We will be coordinating the route and logistics details with Sgt Schiller and Officer Yannazzone.

### **Route Marking**

GFNY crew will begin marking the route of GFNY starting Tuesday, May 9, 2023. Signs will include temporary road marking for turns, signs at eye level that mark turns or caution, mile markers (every 20 miles), aid station signs, water-based paint road markings and some sponsored fence signs where permitted. As in the past years, all signs will be posted in areas that do not affect visibility of the roads/intersections/traffic. All signs will be removed by Monday, May 22, 2023.

### **Background About the Event**

- MEDIA: Cyclists from all over the world attend the event and it receives global media coverage from 33 cycling magazines in 17 languages. National tv, newspaper and magazine media have covered the event.
- COURSE: The event starts on the George Washington Bridge, travels along Route 9W and up to Bear Mountain, the featured climb of the event. The event finishes on Hudson Terrace in Fort Lee, NJ. The event showcases the George Washington Bridge, charming towns in Rockland and Bergen Counties and beautiful nature.
- HEALTH BENEFITS: GFNY promotes and reinforces healthy lifestyles for the participants, spectators, fans and locals. Holding participatory events such as this encourages people to set goals and develop healthy habits, get in shape and become healthier, and experience the great outdoors.
- CHARITY: GFNY makes donations to non-profits based in NY/NJ who provide volunteers at GFNY aid stations, pre-race registration or the finish village. Some GFNY riders choose to raise funds for their chosen causes as part of their participation in GFNY.
- ECONOMIC IMPACT: GFNY holds free weekly group rides for registered participants to prepare for the event utilizing the GFNY route and supporting local bakeries, coffee shops, bike shops and other local businesses. For race day, we source local products and services from area businesses.
- **TOURISM:** Dozens of tour operators bring hundreds of riders and families to the NY/NJ region. Thousands of other GFNY riders and families book their travel individually and boost sales at local businesses like hotels, restaurants, car rental, transport companies and stores.

### Before completing the Showmobile Request Form, please be aware of the following:

+ The total area needed for the Showmobile is a space 50 feet in length, 15 feet in width and 25 feet in height.

+ Showmobile stage measures 28 feet long x 14 feet 7 inches deep x 25 feet high when open. One set of stairs is available with hand railings. (Please note that this measurement does not include the trailer hitch or the tow vehicle).

+ The lights require a 110 volt, 20 amp circuit to plug into within 150 feet of the right front side of the Showmobile. Additional electrical equipment must be plugged into a separate circuit.

+ The Showmobile must be parked in a relatively level space. The placement of the Showmobile is at the discretion of the Orangetown Parks & Recreation staff. Although every effort will be made to meet requests, this equipment does not go off road, over curbing, on uneven ground or over rough terrain.

+ The area must be free of obstructions such as overhanging tree limbs, electrical wires, etc.

+ The tow vehicle must remain with the Showmobile for the duration of the event.

+ In the event of winds in excess of 30 MPH, the stage canopy must be closed.

+ The Town seal is not to be covered and no nails, staples, tacks or tape may be used to attach any items to the Showmobile)

+ The organization will receive an emailed invoice after their event is complete. Payment is expected no later than 14 days after receipt of invoice.

+ A member of the organization renting the unit must be on site at time of arrival for proper set up as well as time of departure to assure all event tasks have been completed (i.e. removal of equipment)

+ Any changes/cancellations (unless otherwise agreed upon) to the event must be made 24 hours in advance by contacting Mark Albert at malbert@orangetown.com.
