RESOLUTION NO. 253

ENGAGE KEANE & BEANE / PROFESSIONAL LEGAL SERVICES / ZONING MATTER

WHEREAS, the Town of Orangetown Supervisor was notified by New York City Mayor Eric Adams on May 5, 2023, of NYC's intention to house certain individuals identified by Mayor Adams as asylum seekers at a location in Orangetown, later learned to be the Armoni

Hotel, located on NY State Route 303, Orangeburg, New York, for an indefinite period of time, but for as much as up to four consecutive months, if not longer, commencing as soon as the day after the call or immediately thereafter, and

WHEREAS, the Town Supervisor subsequently learned from the County of Rockland, that NYC intended to house as many as 340 single adult males in the Armoni Hotel for an extended length of time, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Orangetown is responsible for enforcement of local zoning, building and fire codes, as well as state building and fire codes, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Orangetown has reason to believe that the Armoni Hotel is currently under agreement with NYC for housing individuals in its hotel on a long term basis, in violation of local zoning codes, and the certificate of occupancy currently issued to the Armoni Hotel, to operate as a hotel, and not as a shelter for the City of New York,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board hereby authorizes the Town Attorney to retain the services of Keane & Beane, White Plains, New York, to serve as litigation counsel with respect to this matter. and the illegal and improper use of the subject premises, and authorizes them to commence any action that may be necessary, in a court of competent jurisdiction, and to seek all appropriate legal remedies, to ensure the Town's zoning and building codes are being complied with at the subject property, including but not limited to, injunctive relief.
