Chris and Deanna Keywork appeared.

- 3. Picture of pillar with light.
- 4. Certificate of occupancy for existing fence.

Chris Keywork stated that they have owned the house for eight years; that the existing fence is in poor condition and they would like to replace it with a natural wood fence and spruce it up with the stone pillars and lantern style lights by the entrance and exit of the driveway.

Chair Raso stated that people drive erratically along Route 9W and that she hopes the new fence and pillars do not get damaged.

Chris Keywork replied that there is a drainage ditch running along Route 9W and the structures would be behind that.

William Walther asked about the height of the pillars, and the lights and if it would be capped with bluestone.

Chris Keywork replied that the pillars would be 5' in height and the light would be 2 ½' above that on the wood and the cap would be bluestone.

- 2. The fence is existing.


