## PETITION FOR OUR HOUSE TO BE ZONED AS "RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY" Property Address: 90 W Madison Ave Pearl River, NY 10965

Dear Members of the Town Board:

We are hereby submitting this letter to petition for a zone change of our home which address is listed above. We have recently learned that our property is zoned as a commercial property which imposes strict restrictions on expansions/enlargements.

Last week a zoning officer from town hall confirmed that our house is in fact zoned as a commercial property, and would be denied for an addition that we are planning.

We asked how could a house that has been there for about 100 years be zoned commercial? After further review, we learned that when they drew up the zoning map, it seems that there may have been a possible mistake made.

- Every property in our neighborhood that is on S Pearl St (Rt 304) in Pearl River is zoned Commercial CO.
- Every house in our neighborhood that is directly behind these same properties which are on S Pearl St are zoned Residential RG......**Except for ours**.
- When they drew the zoning line between the Residential-RG zone and the Commercial-CO zone, they turned the zoning line up W Madison Ave which is incorrect. They should have gone 1 more parcel (ours), then turned the zoning line.

You can clearly see this possible error on the attached existing & proposed zoning maps.

OUR HOUSE HAS ALWAYS BEEN A RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY for about 100 years, and we bought it to be used as a residential property, not a commercial one. In fact, I'm sure our neighbors would be upset if we used it as a commercial property. We've raised our kids in this house and they are growing like everyone else's, and we just need more living space. Currently it's only a 2 bedroom 1 bath house, which is undersized for today's living standards. We love the neighborhood and the town and we don't want to move, we just need more space. All of the other houses in our neighborhood are zoned residential.

OUR HOUSE IS THE ONLY PROPERTY ZONED COMMERCIAL.

As stated above, we are a growing family in town and desperately need more living space to live comfortably, and in line with today's living standards.

We kindly ask the Board Members to schedule a hearing as soon as possible to vote on, and hopefully agree that our residential property should be changed back to a residential zone, instead of the current Commercial Zone CO which is not in alignment with our residential neighborhood.










# Second Floor Plan








# LOCAL LAW NO. \_\_\_ OF 2023 OF THE INCORPORATED TOWN OF ORANGETOWN, NEW YORK TOWN BOARD TO AMEND CHAPTER 43 OF THE TOWN CODE OF THE TOWN OF ORANGETOWN RELATED TO SHORT TERM RENTALS

PROPOSED LOCAL LAW NO. \_\_\_\_ OF 2023, AMENDING CHAPTER 43 (ZONING), ARTICLE XV (LANDLORD REGISTRY ACT), OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF ORANGETOWN

Language to be deleted from the existing Code provisions are indicated by a strikethrough; and new language to be added is typed in **bold and underscored**. All other language shown is to remain unchanged and is provided for context.

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Orangetown as follows:

Section 1 – Legislative Findings, Objectives and Purpose of this Local Law No. \_\_\_\_ of 2023: The Town of Orangetown ("Town" or "Orangetown") recognizes that there are rising concerns, and documented instances, that certain residential properties located in residential Zoning Districts within the unincorporated sections of the Town are being inappropriately used as short-term, income generating, commercial rental businesses to the detriment of the health, safety and welfare of neighboring property owners and the public at large, and in violation of the regulations of Chapter 43, Zoning, of the Code of the Town of Orangetown. Some of these rentals have included large parties that have posed public safety concerns, contributed to excessive vehicle traffic and parking problems as well as created an excessive amount of noise and disorder in residential neighborhoods.

In order to provide the Town with necessary additional information with an aim toward ensuring compliance with the legal and permissible uses of residential properties within the Town, and to protect the health, safety and welfare of property owners in residential Zoning Districts, the Town is adopting this Local Law to prohibit the short-term rental of a residence for a period of time that is less than 30 days in duration.

Section 2 – Chapter 43 (Zoning), Article XV (Landlord Registry Act), §43-15, of the Code of the Town of Orangetown ("Orangetown Code"), shall be amended and, as amended, shall read as follows:

§ 15.1 Title.

The Town Council of the Town of Orangetown determines that the title of this local law shall be "Article XV: Landlord Registry Act and Short Term Rentals."

### § 15.2 Purpose and scope.

A. The purpose of this article is to establish a registry of all rental properties, as defined herein, in order to allow its police, building, <u>fire</u> and code enforcement officials to identify and contact, as necessary, persons responsible for the care, maintenance and management of such properties, <u>and to prohibit certain short-term rentals of all properties in residential districts to protect and preserve the Town's appropriately balanced commercial and residential nature and tranquil neighborhood character, and to better ensure the enforcement of local, state and</u>

federal safety regulations in furtherance of the health, safety and welfare of all of the residents of the Town.

B. The provisions of this article shall apply to all rental real property located in the Town of Orangetown.

### § 15.3 Definitions.

For the purpose of this article, the following words and phrases shall have the meanings ascribed to them:

### **ASSEMBLY**

Any indoor or outdoor gathering of people for a common purpose, which includes but is not limited to a wedding, party, event or similar group activity.

#### BUILDING

Any structure within the Town wholly or partially enclosed within exterior walls, or within exterior and party walls, and a roof, affording shelter to persons, animals or property.

### **DWELLING UNIT**

One or more rooms with provision for living, cooking, sanitary and sleeping facilities arranged for the exclusive use of one family.

### **OWNER**

Any individual or individuals, partnership, corporation, LLC, LLP, or other type of entity, and regardless of whether for profit or not-for-profit, in whose name the title to real property within the Town is vested.

### SHORT-TERM RESIDENTIAL RENTAL

A dwelling unit, including but not limited to a house, condominium or other residedntail building or property, that is rented, in whole or in part, to any person, persons, or entity for a period of less than 30 consecutive days. "Rental", for these purposes, means an agreement, written or oral, granting use or possession of a residence, in whole or part, to a person in exchange for monetary compensation or other valuable consideration. The term "short-term rental" does not include hotel or motel rooms, or month-to-month tenancies in dwelling units authorized for that purpose, but includes rentals for purposes of assembly.

### RENTAL PROPERTY

Includes all buildings, as defined herein, containing one or more spaces rented, leased, let, hired or permitted to be occupied, whether for compensation or otherwise, by persons or entities other than the record owner thereof **for a period of 30 consecutive days or longer**.

This definition includes any building containing commercial rental space, residential rental space, or a combination of commercial and residential rental space, but does not include owner-occupied residential buildings <u>or hotels</u>.

### **TENANT**

Any person(s) or entity who has leased the dwelling unit from the owner or landlord, regardless of the type of tenancy under which they occupy the renal unit.

### § 15.4 Registration of ownership rental property.

- A. Registration. Every owner of rental property, as defined herein, shall be required to register such property within a period of 30 days from the effective date of this article with the Town Clerk on such forms as shall be prescribed by the Town Clerk. A new registration form shall be filed whenever there is a change of ownership (and in the case of a corporation, partnership, LLC, LLP or other non-individual owner, whenever there is a change in the majority interest in the owner entity) of a rental property, and it shall be the responsibility of the new owner(s) to file such form within 30 days of taking title to the property.
  - (1) Following the initial registration, a biennial filing shall be made in and between January 1 and February 1, certifying that there has been no change in the status or ownership of the rental property or reflecting the nature of any change.
- B. Registry fee. Every owner of rental property required to register with the Town Clerk shall pay a biennial registration fee as follows:
  - (1) For a building having one to four units: \$20 per rental space or unit;
  - (2) For a building having five to 20 units: \$20 for units one through four, and \$10 per unit for units five through 20;
  - (3) For a building having more than 20 units: the above stated fees for units one through 20, and \$5 for each unit over 20.
  - (4) Such fee shall be paid to the Town of Orangetown, and shall represent the cost of maintaining the registry and conducting periodic inspections and other activities, as may be required in furtherance of the purposes of this article.

### § 15.5 Registry form and filing.

- A. The registry form shall require the following information:
  - (1) The property address and section, block and lot number as appears on the Tax Map of the Town of Orangetown, and the number of residential dwelling units and/or commercial units, as the case may be, permitted to be occupied on each property.
  - (2) The owner(s)' name(s), mailing address(s), street address(s) and telephone numbers (facsimile and email included, if and as available). Post office box numbers may be included, but the physical location at which the owner may be contacted shall be required.
  - (3) Where the property is owned by a corporation, the name, title, address and telephone number of the person designated by the corporation as responsible for the maintenance of

the property and to receive service of process in addition to the Secretary of State, and of each shareholder thereof.

- (4) Where the property is owned by an LLC or LLP, the names and addresses (actual, not post office box) of each manager or managing member or partner, and of each member or partner;
  - (a) Where an LLC or LLP is owned or operated, in whole or in part, by a different LLC or LLP, then the names and addresses of the manager or managing members or partners, as the case may be, of the LLC or LLP which owns the registering LLC or LLP.
- (5) Where day-to-day responsibility for the care and maintenance of the property rests with a person other than the officer, shareholder, manager or managing member or partner set forth on the registration, the name, address and telephone numbers of the person so responsible.
- B. The form shall be signed by one of the owners and his or her designee and before a notary public and shall bear the following statement directly above such signatures: "I certify that all information contained in this statement, including the number of lawful rental spaces or units represented, is true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief. I understand that the willful making of a false statement of material fact herein will subject me to the provisions of law relevant to the making of false instruments and shall constitute a violation of this article. C. It shall be the obligation of each owner to timely notify the Town Clerk whenever the information provided on the biennial registry form has become outdated or for any reason is no longer accurate. It shall be the responsibility of each owner to recertify the aforementioned information every two years.

### §15.6 Short-Term Residential Rentals.

A. Short-Term Residential Rentals prohibited. No owner, lessee, licensee, tenant, or other person, partnership, association, limited liability company or corporation, having any right to, or interest in, any property within the jurisdiction of the unincorporated area of the Town of Orangetown and located in an R-80, R-40, R-22, R-15, RG, MFR or PAC zone, shall license, rent, lease, hire-out, let, or otherwise allow for compensation or remuneration, the use of such property, or any part thereof, for occupancy, whether such occupancy is daily, overnight, or weekly, for a period of less than 30 consecutive days.

- B. Short-Term Rental of Outdoor Pools and Spaces. No owner, lessee, licensee, tenant, or other person, partnership, association, limited liability company or corporation, having any right to, or interest in, any property within the jurisdiction of the unincorporated area of the Town of Orangetown and located in an R-80, R-40, R-22, R-15, RG, MFR or PAC zone, shall license, rent, lease, hire-out, let, or otherwise allow for compensation or remuneration, the use of any outdoor spaces including but not limited to swimming pools, spas, playgrounds, and yards for purposes of assembly.
- C. Exception. Occupancy pursuant to a post-closing possession agreement by the seller of any dwelling unit shall not be a violation of short-term rentals provided that title has passed to the purchaser and the deed for the dwelling unit to the new owner has been

## filed in the Rockland County Clerk's Office on the same day or within five days of closing.

- § 15.67 Penalties for offenses; **Enforcement**.
- A. No rental property <u>or short-term rental</u>, as defined herein, shall be occupied except in compliance with the provisions herein, and the failure to comply shall constitute a violation of a certificate of occupancy or other legal status permitting the use and occupancy of the building.
- B. Any person who shall violate any provision of this article shall be punishable as provided in § 41A-1 of this Code, in addition to any civil penalties or remedies as may apply.
- C. Civil remedies. In the event an owner fails or refuses to correct a violation under this article, the Town may commence a civil action, request injunctive relief, and seek money damages to compensate the Town for the costs it has and will incur because of the violation, including reasonable attorney's fees expended by the Town.
- D. Other remedies. The remedies provided for in this section are in addition to, and not in lieu of, all other legal remedies, criminal or civil, which may be pursued by the Town to address any violation of the Town Code or other public nuisance.
- E. This Article may be enforced by the Orangetown Office of Building, Zoning and Planning Administration and Enforcement, the Orangetown Bureau of Fire Prevention and/or the Orangetown Police Department.

### §15.8 Presumptive Evidence of a Violation.

- A. The presence or existence of any of the following is presumptive evidence that a residence is being used for a short-term rental:
  - (1) Person(s) occupying or present at the residence state that he/she/they have leased, rented, licensed or hired the residence from the owner, or paid the owner or some other person or entity to be a guest(s), for a time period of less than 30 consecutive days.
  - (2) The residence has been published in printed or online/internet sources as being available for short-term rental.
- B. If any of the following documents of a property owner sets forth an address other than that of a residential property, it is presumptive evidence that an owner of a property does not reside at said property:
  - (1) Voter registration
  - (2) Motor vehicle registration
  - (3) Driver's license
  - (4) Any other document signed by the owner

The foregoing may be rebutted by reliable evidence presented to the Town of Orangetown.

### §15-10 Severability.

If any provision, clause, sentence, paragraph, section or part of this Article XV shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the provision, clause, sentence, paragraph, section or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered.

### §15-11. When Effective.

This article shall take effect upon publishing and posting, and upon filing a copy with the New York State Secretary of State, as may be required by law.

# AMENDING CHAPTERS 24 & 39 OF THE TOWN CODE ENTITLED "PARKING LOTS & METERS" & "VEHICLES & TRAFFIC" OF THE TOWN CODE

, seconded by	, introduced the
following proposed local law, to be known as Local Law No.	of 2023, entitled "A LOCAL LAW OF
THE TOWN OF ORANGETOWN, ROCKLAND COUNTY	, NEW YORK AMENDING CHAPTERS
24 & 39 Within South Nyack Hamlet."	

SECTION 1. Statement of Legislative Intent. The Village of South Nyack was formally dissolved as a legislative jurisdiction on April 1, 2022 as that same area became a part of the Town of Orangetown jurisdiction. Per the 'South Nyack Final Dissolution Plan', July, 2021, by Laberge Group, page 18, pursuant to GML Article 17-A §789, all Village local laws, ordinances, rules or regulations, in effect on the date of dissolution shall remain effective for a period of up to two (2) years following dissolution, or until such time as the Town board shall adopt, repeal, or integrate such laws into the Town code. Moreover, such local laws shall be enforced by the Town within the limits of the dissolved Village as if they had been duly adopted by the Town Board. Based upon the March 2023 'Draft Hamlet of South Nyack Parking Study', by Laberge Group, this local law proposes a new comprehensive framework of Town policies that regulate parking and related aspects of circulation within the hamlet of South Nyack. This local law also provides for the repeal of associated former Village laws, since they will no longer be controlling upon the adoption of this local law.

**SECTION 2.** New proposed town code changes are described below. New proposed code is shown as underlined, while if text of the existing text is removed, the text shown as removed is stricken, meaning it has a line through it.

**SECTION 3.** Chapter 39, Article I, Subsection 39-3 'Prohibition of all-night parking', enable exclusions, for select streets, by adding within subsection A. a new:

### (5) In the Hamlet of South Nyack: as follows:

- (a) Clinton Avenue, on the south side, west of South Franklin Street;
- (b) Cooper Drive, on the east side between Clinton Avenue and White Avenue;
- (c) Division Avenue, on the north side from Depot Place to South Broadway; and
- (d) Washington Avenue, on the south side between South Broadway and 75 feet north of Glen Byron Avenue.

**SECTION 4.** Within Chapter 39, Article I, Subsection 39-5, "Prohibition of stopping, standing or parking in specified places" of the Town of Orangetown Town Code, add a subsection and criteria under a new subsection heading for the South Nyack hamlet. It will provide for the following prescriptions that will specifically designate prohibited parking areas. It will identify specific subsections or portions of streets where parking allowances for autos and/or other vehicles within the hamlet of South Nyack are expressly excluded, as follows:

Provide a new M. In the Hamlet of South Nyack: and recodify existing M as N, and then in M add:

- (1) Berachah Avenue, on east side, for its entire distance southerly from the intersection of Lowland Drive, and west side from 345 feet south of the intersection with Terrace Drive to a point 35 feet north of the northern edge of pavement on the western extending section of College Avenue;
- (2) South Broadway, on the east side, for a distance of 115 feet southerly from the intersection of the east side of South Broadway with the south side of Cedar Hill Avenue and for a distance of 75 feet on the west side of South Broadway southerly from the intersection of the west side of South Broadway with the south side of Cedar Hill Avenue;
- (3) South Broadway, on the east or west side, for a distance of 75 feet northerly and 75 feet southerly from the points formed by the intersection of the curblines of South Broadway and Clinton Avenue;
- (4) <u>Brookside Avenue</u>, north side, for a distance of 15 feet easterly from the intersection with Cooper Drive;
- (5) <u>Brookside Avenue</u>, north side, from the intersection of the curbline of the north side of Brookside Avenue with the west curbline of Depot Place for a distance of 25 feet westerly from the intersection of said curblines;
- (6) <u>Brookside Avenue</u>, north side, from the intersection of the curbline of the north side of Brookside Avenue with the east curbline of Depot Place for a distance of 25 feet easterly from the intersection of said curblines;
- (7) <u>Cedar Hill Avenue</u>, north side, the entire length from Piermont <u>Avenue</u> to <u>Anna Street</u>;
- (8) <u>Cedar Hill Avenue</u>, south side, for a distance of 72 feet westerly from the intersection west of South Broadway and 30 feet easterly from the intersection east of South Broadway;
- (9) Cedar Hill Avenue, south side, for a distance of 45 feet easterly from the intersection with Depot Place;
- (10) Cedar Hill Avenue, south side, for a distance of 50 feet easterly from the intersection with South Franklin Street;
- (11) Cedar Hill Avenue, south side, for a distance of 50 feet easterly from the intersection with Washington Street;
- (12) Clinton Avenue, south side, between South Broadway and South Franklin Street;
- (13) Clinton Avenue, both sides, west of South Broadway for a distance of 75 feet;
- (14) Cooper Drive, west side, between Clinton Avenue and White Avenue;
- (15) Depot Place, east side, entire length;
- (16) Depot Place, west side, from the intersection of the north curbline of Brookside Avenue with the west curbline of Depot Place for a distance of 25 feet northerly from the intersection of said curbline;
- (17) <u>Division Avenue</u>, south side, for a distance of 40 feet westerly from the intersection with South Broadway;
- (18) Elysian Avenue, north side, easterly from Franklin Street to Prospect Street;

- (19) South Franklin Street, both sides, from Cedar Hill Avenue to the Route 9W egress/ one-way exit onto South Franklin Street;
- (20) Glen Byron Avenue, west side, entire length;
- (21) Hamilton Place, north side, entire length;
- (22) Piermont Avenue, both sides, from Smith Avenue extending 1,045 feet southerly, which is the former location of the Village of South Nyack municipal boundary with the Village of Grandview;
- (23) <u>Piermont Avenue</u>, west side, from Cedar Hill Avenue westerly to a point 75 feet south of the south line of Voorhis Avenue;
- (24) <u>Prall Place</u>, both sides, between its intersection with the east side of South Broadway to its intersection with the west side of Piermont Avenue;
- (25) <u>Salisbury Place</u>, both sides, a distance of 350 feet easterly from the intersection with the east side of Piermont Avenue;
- (26) Shadyside Avenue, both sides, for a distance 200 feet from the intersection with Route 9W;
- (27) Shadyside Avenue, east side, entire length;
- (28) Smith Avenue, north side, entire length;
- (29) Smith Avenue, south side, for a distance 215 feet easterly from the intersection with Piermont Avenue;
- (30) <u>Terrace Drive</u>, west side, for a distance of 50 feet northerly from the point at which Berachah <u>Avenue and Terrace Drive meet (a storm drain catch basin is a reference point);</u>
- (31) <u>Terrace Drive</u>, west side, from 35 feet east/southeast (downgradient) of Prospect Avenue extending uphill, or generally northwesterly, all the way to the South Highland Avenue/ South Boulevard intersection;
- (32) <u>Voorhis Avenue</u>, north side, the entire segment from South Broadway to Piermont Avenue.

**SECTION 5.** Chapter 39, Article I, Subsection 39-6, "Prohibition of parking on designated highways." Within this subsection of the Town of Orangetown Town Code, add the following restricted parking areas, that will prohibit parking for autos and/or other vehicles within the hamlet of South Nyack, as follows:

Provide a new H. In the Hamlet of South Nyack: and add:

- (1) Chase Avenue, both sides, entire length;
- (2) College Avenue, both sides, entire length;
- (3) Highland Avenue, both sides, entire length;
- (4) Livingston Place; both sides, entire length;
- (5) Lowland Drive, both sides, entire length;
- (6) Prospect Avenue, both sides, entire length;
- (7) <u>South Boulevard, both sides, from South Highland Avenue, extending to 1,255 feet south of the College Avenue intersection, which point was the former South Nyack municipal boundary line;</u>

- (8) South Highland Avenue, both sides, from the intersection of Route 9W southerly to the Highland Avenue/ Terrace Drive intersection; and
- (9) <u>Upland Drive</u>, both sides, for its entire 0.28 mile length, from Highland Avenue in an easterly direction, to the intersection with South Boulevard.

**SECTION 6.** Chapter 39, Article I, Subsection 39-7, "Time Limitation on parking." Within this subsection of the Town of Orangetown Town Code, add the following stipulations restricting the times allowed for parking of autos and/or other vehicles in certain areas within the hamlet of South Nyack, as follows:

In order to establish two-hour limits in the Hamlet provide a new A.(5) In the Hamlet of South Nyack: and add:

- (1) <u>Brookside Avenue</u>, both sides, from South Broadway to Franklin Street:
- (2) <u>Cedar Hill Avenue</u>, south side, from South Broadway to Depot Place;
- (3) Clinton Avenue, both sides, west of South Franklin Street;
- (4) Clinton Avenue, north side, from South Broadway westerly to South Franklin Street;
- (5) Clinton Avenue, both sides, southerly from South Broadway east to the end of Clinton Avenue;
- (6) Depot Place, both sides, from Cedar Hill Avenue to Brookside Avenue;
- (7) <u>Division Avenue</u>, both sides, from Depot Place to South Broadway, with parking permitted for vehicles with valid handicapped permits only on south side, from a point 120 feet westerly from Broadway to a point 140 feet westerly from the intersection with S. Broadway;
- (8) Elizabeth Place, both sides, for the entire length;
- (9) South Franklin Street, east side, the entire length from Clinton Avenue to Brookside Avenue;
- (10) Gesner Avenue, both sides, from the eastern end of the street (edge of pavement of the dead-end) to a point 225 feet west therefrom the d until the hour of 8:30 p.m.;
- (11) Hamilton Place, south side, for the entire length;
- (12) Mansfield Avenue, north side, beginning from the intersection with South Broadway and continuing 50 feet in an easterly direction;
- (13) Piermont Avenue, east side, from Voorhis Avenue to Cedar Hill Avenue;
- (14) South Broadway, east side, from Clinton Avenue to Cornelison Avenue,
- (15) <u>South Broadway</u>, east and west side, from Cedar Hill Avenue to Clinton Avenue, Monday through <u>Saturday</u>;
- (16) South Broadway, west side, from Clinton Avenue south for a distance of 475 feet;
- (17) South Broadway, west side, starting at a point 95 feet north of the north side curbline of the New York State Thruway ramp and continuing for a distance of 20 feet, parking is permitted for vehicles with valid handicapped permits only;
- (18) Voorhis Avenue, both sides for the entire length, from Piermont Avenue to Depot Place; and

(19) White Avenue, both sides, for the entire length.

Moreover, in order to establish 15-minute limits in the Hamlet, provide a new <u>C.(2)</u> In the Hamlet of South Nyack: and add:

(1) Cedar Hill Avenue, south side, from Piermont Avenue to Broadway, except that for the first 15 feet of the parking area east of Broadway on the south side of Cedar Hill Avenue, parking will be permitted for 15 minutes only;

**SECTION 7.** Chapter 39, §12, "One-way streets and prohibited turns." within this part of Town of Orangetown Town Code, add these standards for certain streets in the hamlet of South Nyack, as follows:

Provide a new G. In the Hamlet of South Nyack: and add:

- (1) College Avenue beginning at a point in the center line of College Avenue (said point is 300 feet southeasterly measured along the center line of South Boulevard); thence running southerly, easterly, northerly along College Avenue to Chase Avenue; thence continuing northerly along Chase Avenue to Prospect Avenue; and
- (2) Prospect Avenue, northerly, entire length.

**SECTION 8.** Brookside Municipal Parking Lot. Amend Town Code Chapter 24 'Parking Lots & Meters', as follows, in order to affirm that this lot is to be used for parking by residents and to affirm that there are standards for public parking for noncommercial vehicles at this property, with the legislative intent for this part to establish and affirm the requirement that there will be requirements for municipal parking permits in order to park at this location (criteria for the municipal parking permit is defined in §24-1.E.) and also as follows:

Amend Article I - Municipal Parking Lots, §24-1 "Permit parking in municipal parking lots":

Subsection A. by adding the following clause so it now reads: The Town shall permit use of its Town parking lots for parking of motor vehicles located in the downtown Pearl River area <u>and the</u> Hamlet of South Nyack.

Subsection B. by breaking it into two parts and adding, after the first clause: "The municipal parking lots to which this section shall apply are the following Town-owned lots:", and so it now has:

- (1) Pearl River: Parking Lot No. 1, located between East Washington Avenue and East Central Avenue; Parking Lot No. 2, located on the south side of William Street, south of Franklin Avenue; Parking Lot No. 3, located on the corner of East Washington Avenue and North William Street.
- (2) South Nyack: Brookside Avenue Surface Parking Lot on the South side of the street at 67 Brookside Avenue.

Also, amend and fix the current codification in Article I §24-3 "Penalties for offenses.", by providing notation consistent with the rest of this Article, by adding A. Area of Town before the corrected (1);

Edit existing (1) changing the text before the table so that it reads:

For all <u>Pearl River other</u> municipal lot violations, the following fine schedule is applicable to the registered owner of the vehicle:

**SECTION 9.** Pursuant to and consistent with existing Town Chapter 39, Article I, Subsection § 39-5.1. 'Fire lanes.' Add N. and the recodify existing M. into N., and add the following new text for M. Hamlet of South Nyack (former Village of South Nyack). Pursuant to and consistent with existing Town Chapter 39, Article I, Subsection § 39-5.1. 'Fire lanes.', if within the hamlet of South Nyack there is a proposed site plan or site plan amendment, and prior plans running with the land show Fire Lanes designated on any portions of associated public streets or public rights of ways, the location and arrangement of such fire lanes shall be shown on all plan submissions and shall not be removed or extinguished except in compliance with any applicable Town zoning standards, or the New York State Uniform Fire Prevention & Building Code, whichever is more restrictive.

**SECTION 10.** In existing Town Chapter 39, Article I, § 39-11. 'Heavy trucking.', provide for limitations, except for deliveries on local streets, by adding a new <u>G. In the Hamlet of South Nyack:</u> and adding:

- (1) <u>Brookside Avenue</u>;
- (2) <u>Clinton Avenue, west of South Franklin Street;</u>
- (3) <u>Elysian Ave</u>;
- (4) <u>Lowland Drive</u>;
- (5) <u>Mansfield Avenue</u>;
- (6) <u>Maple Street</u>;
- (7) <u>Prospect Street;</u>
- (8) Shadyside Avenue;
- (9) <u>Terrace Drive</u>;
- (10) Voorhis Avenue;
- (11) Washington Avenue;
- (12) Washington Street; and
- (13) White Avenue.

**SECTION 11.** Repeal Village Code Chapter 220 Parking.

**SECTION 12.** Repeal selected Village Code Articles or Sections from Chapter 310 'Vehicles & Traffic'. These parts applicable to the management and regulation of parking and circulation within the former Village of South Nyack are hereby repealed in their entirety for purposes of continuity in application of the Orangetown Town Code within the Hamlet of South Nyack (which was formerly the Village prior to its dissolution on April 1, 2022). There are either existing adequate standards in Town of Orangetown Town Code, or content is proposed to be included that adequately address such areas and present alternative standards for incorporation into Town of Orangetown Town Code as defined above:

- a. Chapter 310 Article I through Article IX;
- b. Chapter 310 Article X; and
- c. Chapter 310 Articles XIII through XV.

### **SECTION 13.** Numbering for Codification -

It is the intention of the Town of Orangetown and it is hereby enacted, that the provisions of this Local Law shall be included in the Code of the Town of Orangetown; that sections and subsections of this Local Law may be re-numbered or re-lettered by the Codifier to accomplish such intention; that the Codifier shall make no substantive changes to this Local Law; that the word "Local Law" shall be changed to "Chapter," "Section" or other appropriate word as required for Codification; and that any such numbering and editing shall not affect the validity of this Local Law or the provisions of the Code affected thereby.

### **SECTION 14.** Severability.

The provisions of this Local Law are separable and if any provision, clause, sentence, subsection, word or part thereof is held illegal, invalid or unconstitutional, or inapplicable to any person or circumstance, such illegality, invalidity or unconstitutionality, or inapplicability shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, clauses, sentences, subsections, words or parts of this Local Law or their petition to other persons or circumstances. It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent that this Local Law would have been adopted if such illegal, invalid or unconstitutional provision, clause, sentence, subsection, word or part had not been included therein, and if such person or circumstance to which the Local Law or part hereof is held inapplicable had been specifically exempt there from.

### **SECTION 15.** Effective Date

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Office of the Secretary of State of the State of New York.



### THIS COVENANT, HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFICATION

**AGREEMENT** (this "Agreement") made as of this day of July 2023, by and between Lisa Ferrante and 1031 Route 9W, Upper Grandview, New York 10960, the party of the first part, and the **TOWN OF ORANGETOWN**, a Municipal Corporation, having an address at Town Hall, 26 Orangeburg Road, Orangeburg, New York 10962, the party of the second part.

### **RECITALS:**

WHEREAS, the party of the first part represents and warrants that she is the owner in fee simple of premises more particularly described in Schedule "A" annexed hereto and known as and by street address number: 1031 Route 9W, Upper Grandview, New York 10960, in the Town of Orangetown, County of Rockland, and being designated on the Orangetown Tax Map as Section 71.09, Block 1, Lot 17 (the "premises"), and the party of the second part has a right-of-way as granted to the party of the second part by the party of the first part on which the party of the first part has constructed a carport roof section that overhangs fifteen (15) inches onto the said right-of-way being as depicted on the Survey, as defined below for 1031 Route 9W, Upper Grandview, New York 10960; and

**WHEREAS**, the party of the first part had erected the carport with this roof projection onto this easement without seeking approval, a permit, or consent from the any Town Department, agency or Board; and

WHEREAS, the party of the first part wishes said carport roof projection and concrete block which supports this roof to continue to remain within the party of the second part's right-of-way as it presently does so as to continue the present beneficial nature of same, from both an economic and aesthetic standpoint to the party of the first part; and

WHEREAS, the party of the second part is agreeable to granting the party of the first part an irrevocable license in order to maintain, and continue to maintain, said carport roof projection, on the express condition that an agreement, running with the land, is made, in recordable form, which provides, inter alia, that: (1) the party of the first part will, upon receipt of written notice ("Notice") from the party of the second part, remove or cause to be removed, the said carport roof projection a reasonable period of time thereafter, but, in no event later than thirty (30) days following the date of the Notice; (2) the party of the second part will not, as a result of, or in connection with, or related to, incur any liability in or any responsibility for the removal, upkeep, repair, replacement, restoration and/or maintenance of the said carport roof projection and concrete block which supports this roof; (3) the party of the first part will not assert against the party of the second part any relinquishment or abandonment, or claims thereof, or other estate, interest and/or rights held by the party of the second part in or to the right-of-way, or any part

thereof; and (4) the party of the first part agrees, at its sole cost and expense, to indemnify and hold harmless and defend the party of the second part from and against any and all liability or responsibility, resulting from, or in connection with, or related to, the removal, upkeep, repair, replacement, restoration and/or maintenance of the said carport roof projection and concrete block which supports this roof, or claims thereof.

### **WITNESSETH:**

**NOW, THEREFORE,** in consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) paid by the party of the first part to the party of the second part, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the foregoing Recitals (the "Recitals") and or other good and valuable consideration, the parties hereto, intending to be legally bound, hereby agree as follows:

**FIRST:** All of the Recitals are, by this reference thereto, incorporated herein with the same force and effect as if repeated herein in their entirety.

**SECOND:** Subject to the terms and conditions herein set forth, the party of the second part hereby creates and grants to the party of the first part an irrevocable license over and across the right-of-way for the purposes of maintaining and continuing to maintain, in its present location, the party of the first party's existing carport roof projection and concrete block which supports this roof as shown or depicted on site plan prepared by Jay Greenwell, PLS, dated August 27, 2020 and revised January 23, 2023 and which the party of the first part acknowledges and agrees does project upon the party of the second part's right-of-way.

THIRD: The party of the first part agrees to indemnify and hold harmless and defend the party of the second part from any and all liability or responsibility in connection with, or related to, the said carport roof projection and concrete block which supports this roof and/or this Agreement, including, without limitation, any claims, proceedings, legal fees, and any and all liability and responsibility in connection therewith or related thereto, and any damage or injury to the right of way area and/or the premises which may be the result of, or attributable to, any damage or injury caused by the party of the second part, its employees and/or agents due to the failure or timely failure of the party of the first part to act hereunder or comply herewith, or with any Notice given it, in accordance with, or pursuant to, or as contemplated by the provisions of this Agreement and which are the express obligation hereunder on the part of the party of the first part to perform and/or which result, directly or indirectly, from the exercise by the party of the second part of its rights under, or related or incidental to, the right-of-way.

**FOURTH:** The party of the first part agrees not to assert against the party of the second part any relinquishment or abandonment, or claims thereof, or other estate, interest and/or rights held by the party of the second part in or to the right of way, or any part thereof, and further agrees that the irrevocable license hereby created or granted to it by the party of the second part neither impairs nor diminishes any of the rights afforded to the party of the second part by virtue of the right of way.

The race will be held (with your approval) on Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> September, 2023, to benefit local First responders, Soup Kitchens and the Rockland Road Runners Scholarship Fund. This year, we are returning to our traditional 10-mile route that starts in South Nyack and passes through Grand View-on-Hudson and Piermont. We request the following assistance:

- Highway Department: Road use
- Parks Department: Use of Franklin Street Park and the Raymond G. Esposito Trail
- Police Department: Traffic control and escort vehicle.

### **Event Details**

Runners will assemble on South Franklin Street between Cedar Hill Ave and Elysian Ave commencing at 8:15 AM. The race *starts at 8:30 AM*. The *race ends at 11:00 AM*; runners are advised that the course will be closed at this time.

### Franklin Park

We request that the 110V electricity supply at the Gazebo be turned on be turned on by 6:30 AM until 12:30 PM on Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> September and that the public toilets in the park be unlocked at the same time.

### Route Description




Figure 2: Start Area Detail

The overall route is shown in Figure 1 and the Start Area in Figure 2. Runners travel south on Franklin Street, turn left on Clinton Ave, right on Broadway, then left onto Cornelison Ave and right onto Piermont Ave. Runners remain on Piermont Ave / River Road as it passes through Grand View-on-Hudson and enters Piermont. Runners make their way through Piermont, turning left onto Paradise Ave and proceeding to the end of the pier, where they turn and retrace their path through Piermont and Grand View. After re-entering South Nyack, runners turn left onto Cornelison, then left again to head south on Broadway uphill to access the Esposito trail before the intersection with 9W. Runners continue on the Esposito trail, crossing Clinton Street and Brookside Ave to finish in Franklin Street Park. Table 1 shows the approximate times for the fastest and slowest runners at key locations on the course.

### Road Closures and Barriers




Figure 3: Orangetown Road Traffic Control

We request the complete closing of Franklin Street from Cedar Hill to Clinton Street between 8:10 AM and 8:40 AM so that runners can assemble for the start and run unencumbered until they have spread out enough to share the road. We also request the closure of Cornelison Ave (except for local traffic) to prevent problems with turning traffic at the Broadway and Piermont Ave intersections. We request police support to enforce these closures. The locations of these barriers is shown in the detail of the Orangetown streets in Figure 3.

We request a total of 16 barriers (sawhorses or equivalent) to temporarily close off the following intersections beginning at 8:10 AM.

- Franklin Street and Cedar Hill Avenue (2)
- Elysian Ave at Franklin Street (2)

- White Ave at Franklin Street (2)
- Brookside Ave at Franklin Street (4)
- Clinton Street/Franklin Intersection (4)
- Cornelison at Broadway and at Piermont Ave (2)

We request assistance to control traffic where the Esposito trail crosses Clinton and Brookside while the runners are returning along the trail.

### Lead and Sweep Police Vehicle

We request that a lead police vehicle precede the first runner along the entire route and a sweep vehicle follow the last runner. This will require coordination with the Piermont Police department. The first runner will be travelling at approximately 11 mph; the last runner at approximately 4 mph.




