The site is located at 439 Valentine Avenue, Sparkill, Town of Orangetown, Rockland County, New York, and as shown on the Orangetown Tax Map as Section 78.05, Block 1, Lot 10; CS zoning district.

Heard by the Architecture and Community Appearance Board of Review of the Town of Orangetown at a meeting held Thursday, July 20, 2023, at which time the Board made the following determinations:

Maile Shinin appeared and testified. The Board received the following items:

- A. Material Specification Sheet.
- B. Building Permit Referral prepared by Rick Oliver, dated June 26, 2023.
- C. Sign Plans prepared by Garcia Enterprises, Hispana Signs, dated June 14, 2023.

## **FINDINGS OF FACT:**

- 1. The Board found that the applicant proposed to place a 15' by 3' sign with a main field color of white. The lettering "Elite" would be red and the words "Auto Body Inc." would be black. The telephone number and "All Insurance Accepted" would be white on a black band and the logo lines would be black. The materials would be aluminum with 1" frame with vinyl decal over aluminum board. The sign would be attached to the wall on stainless steel crews and sealed with silicone.
- 2. The Board found that the sign would not have lighting and would be placed on the building façade as noted on the submitted drawings.

The hearing was then opened to the Public. There being no one to be heard from the public, the Public Hearing portion of the meeting was closed.

Heard by the Architecture and Community Appearance Board of Review of the Town of Orangetown at a meeting held **Thursday**, **July 20**, **2023**, at which time the Board made the following determinations:

Stephen Kettinger, Ross Pinski and Liam Lowry appeared and testified. The Board received the following items:

- A. Material Specification Sheet and Project Narrative.
- **B.** Site, Landscaping and Architectural Plans signed and stamped by Jeffrey Zutz, RA, Entitled Pfizer Pearl River Project Vitality, dated July 6, 2023.
- **C.** Letter from Fuss & O'Neill Consulting Engineers, dated July 5, 2023, signed by Kristen Solloway, PE, Vice President.
- **D**. Copy of Planning Board Preliminary Site Plan Approval subject to Conditions, dated June 28, 2023, PB #23-33.

## **FINDINGS OF FACT:**

- 1. The Board found that the proposed redevelop of the site would be a new research and development 5 -story structure, with a new parking structure. New landscaping and lighting is proposed. The finishes of the building would match Building #200, the façade would be red brick colored terra cotta and profiled & plate aluminum panel painted. The mechanical equipment would be placed on the roof.
- **2.** The Board found that the landscaping would consist of native plantings in fall colors.

- 2. At the next appearance the applicant shall provide the following information:
  - Color Elevations of the proposed structures
  - Site plan should include sight lines to the other roadways
  - Rendering of the proposed landscaping
  - Show screening at NYS Route 304 and Middletown Road
