## **General Meeting Notes:**

- Veolia is installing treatment to reduce PFAS, aiming to meet the EPA's new standards
- Information highlighting the different water quality standards to be included in the plan
- Veolia samples their various water sources on a regular schedule
- 2024 Water Quality report is now available
- Paul Heisig's <u>Water Resources of Rockland County report</u> was thorough on groundwater
- Differentiate between water withdrawal facilities and wells in plan
- Rockland County is currently updating their comprehensive plan, a future goal of this plan could include review and updates to the maps based on the outcome of this plan

## **Additions to Maps:**

- Adjust legend so that it is located on the side of the page for all maps
- Include an inset map on the zoomed in source water area maps
- Will rename Water Quality map to Water Resources map
- Label additional streams on the Water Resources map
- Delineate lakes on the Water Resources map and change the color so that it stands out more
- Change the critical environmental areas color on the Water Resources map from gray
- Review the critical environmental areas in Orangetown, one of the areas was likely removed when South Nyack dissolved
- Include water withdrawal facilities on the Water Resources Map, but retain them on the Potential Contaminant Source map
- Create a watershed map for Orangetown for reference
- Identify the parcels related to the public water supply system as "Public Water Supply Parcels" instead of Public Service parcels on the Potential Contaminant Source Maps
- Cross reference GIS data on maps with GIS data available through the Rockland County GIS portal
