 - Identify where the plan will be available for the public
- **How will progress be monitored and/or documented**
 - Discuss progress report frequency

Chapter 2: Drinking Water Source Assessment

- **Complete drinking water source protection maps**
 - Include a description of the ownership and control areas, the critical area, and the source water area
 - Discuss NYS Sanitary Code regarding ownership and control areas for groundwater wells
 - Discuss how the critical areas and source water areas were defined
 - Include any relevant studies used to determine the protection areas
- **Create a potential contaminant source inventory**
 - Include a list of assessed potential contaminant sources and denote which are located within the protection areas
 - Summarize where the potential contaminant source information came from, including local knowledge
