Notes on Chapter 4:

- Orangetown Supervisor will be listed as the Plan Management Team (PMT) lead
 - This is a catch all for the current and all future Supervisors and will be noted as part of the succession planning
- PMT Members:
 - Veolia will serve on an as needed basis
 - Rockland County Water Task Force will serve on an as needed basis
 - Orangetown Departments:
 - Highway Department
 - Parks and Recreation Office
 - Building, Zoning, Planning, Administration, and Enforcement
- Revision timeline for the Plan will be set as annual
- The revisions, updates, progress reports will be shared through Orangetown's DWSP2 website

Notes on Chapter 5:

Notes on Chapter 2:

- Veolia indicated that for security reasons, it would be best not to include the exact well locations on the maps
 - The maps will be updated to include labels on the source water areas to offer clarity. Veolia to review the maps.
- Under 2.2.2.7 Remediation Sites, the location of Lederle Lab is not clear. There are two campuses (Pfizer and Hudson Valley iCampus), with two different companies near the site, so this will be updated to ensure clarity.

- Updates will be made to this Chapter to ensure clear connection between the potential contaminant sources listed and the priority issues/Project Profiles developed in Chapter 3

Notes on Chapter 3:

- Project Profile 1: The septic system replacement fund is not listed as a funding source since it does not directly assist Orangetown with funding this project, however its benefits to property owners will be emphasized in this measure.
- Project Profile 2: To provide more clarity, emphasis will be made that this intermunicipal group will be hosted by the Rockland County Water Task Force and Orangetown's Supervisor will participate as a representing member.
- All Project Profiles: project costs will be reevaluated and broken down to ensure they are representative of the required actions for future budgetary use.
