5. **LEAD AGENCY AND DETERMINATION OF SEQRA / PROPOSED LOCAL LAW AMENDING / TOWN CODE CHAPTER 39, VEHICLES & TRAFFIC, ARTICLE I, VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, SECTION 39-8 STOP INTERSECTIONS**

RESOLVED, that the Town Board declares itself Lead Agency in this matter, and further determines that such action is a Type II action pursuant to SEQRA, that the action will not have a significant adverse environmental impact, and, therefore, no further action is necessary with respect thereto under the State Environmental Quality Review Act.

6. **ADOPT LOCAL LAW ____, 2025/ AMENDING TOWN CODE CHAPTER 39, VEHICLES & TRAFFIC, ARTICLE I, VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, SECTION 39-8 STOP INTERSECTIONS**

RESOLVED, that the Town Board hereby adopts Local Law ____, 2025 to amend the Town Code, Chapter 39, Vehicles & Traffic, Article I, Vehicle and Traffic Regulations, Section 39-8 Stop Intersections.

**LOCAL LAW NO. ____ - 2025 OF THE TOWN OF ORANGETOWN,
AMENDING CHAPTER 39 (VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC), ARTICLE I (VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC
REGULATIONS) OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF ORANGETOWN**

As amended, additions are underlined. Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Orangetown as follows:

Section 1.

Legislative Findings, Objectives and Purpose of this Local Law No. ____ of 2025: The Town of Orangetown Traffic Advisory Board, having investigated issues related to congestion and safety in the Hamlets of Orangeburg and Blauvelt, recommends the Town Board adopt these local laws amending the Town Code, to install Stop Signs at multiple locations in the Hamlets of Orangeburg and Blauvelt, previously installed under a 6-month police regulation to be reviewed after 6 months pursuant to Town Board resolution 522 of 2024. Having reviewed the 6-month police regulation and held a public hearing on the matter, the Town Board finds the Stop Signs at these intersections are necessary for traffic safety.

Section 2.

Chapter 39 (Vehicles and Traffic), Article I (Vehicle and Traffic Regulations), §39-8, of the Code of the Town of Orangetown ("Orangetown Code"), shall be amended so as to add the following new subsections (72) through (79) to paragraph "B" of Section 39-8, and, as amended, shall read as follows:

39-8. Stop Intersections.

The following intersections are hereby designated as stop intersections, and all vehicles approaching said intersections as hereinafter set forth shall, before entering the intersection, come to a full stop, unless otherwise directed by a peace officer or signal.

B. In the Hamlet of Orangeburg:

(72) Jim Dean Drive at Route 303

(73) Devon Drive at Parkway Drive South

- (74) Carlton Road at Parkway Drive South
- (75) Chestnut Oval (south/east entrance) at Parkway Drive South
- (76) Cypress Lane at Parkway Drive South for traffic proceeding west on Cypress Lane
- (77) Cypress Lane at Parkway Drive South for traffic proceeding east on Cypress Lane
- (78) Chestnut Oval (north/west entrance) at Parkway Drive South
- (79) Chestnut Oval (north/east entrance) at Parkway Drive South

Section 3.

Chapter 39 (Vehicles and Traffic), Article I (Vehicle and Traffic Regulations), §39-8, of the Code of the Town of Orangetown ("Orangetown Code"), shall be amended so as to add the following new subsections (52) through (58) to paragraph "C" of Section 39-8, and, as amended, shall read as follows:

39-8. Stop Intersections.

The following intersections are hereby designated as stop intersections, and all vehicles approaching said intersections as hereinafter set forth shall, before entering the intersection, come to a full stop, unless otherwise directed by a peace officer or signal.

C. In the Hamlet of Blauvelt:

- (52) Birchwood Road at Parkway Drive North
- (53) Birchwood Court at Parkway Drive North
- (54) Hoffman Lane at Parkway Drive North
- (55) Ashwood Drive (south entrance) at Parkway Drive North
- (56) Beechwood Road at Parkway Drive North
- (57) Ashwood Drive (north entrance) at Parkway Drive North
- (58) East Road at Parkway Drive North

Section 4. Authority

This proposed Local Law is enacted and adopted pursuant to NYS Municipal Home Rule Law §10, and in accordance with the procedures prescribed in NYS Municipal Home Rule §20.

Section 5. Severability

If any section, subdivision, paragraph, clause or phrase of this Local Law shall be adjudged invalid, or held to be unconstitutional, by any court of competent jurisdiction, any judgment or order made thereby shall not affect the validity of this Local Law as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the part or provision so adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 6. Effective Date

This Local Law shall become effective immediately upon filing with the New York State Secretary of State.

7. **APPROVE PERMIT AGREEMENT / BUSINESSES TO DISPENSE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON TOWN PROPERTY / PEARL RIVER DAY / SATURDAY, OCTOBER 18, 2025**

WHEREAS, the Pearl River Chamber of Commerce has formally requested on behalf of the member businesses it represents, permission, pursuant to Town Code Section 10-4(B)(1) to dispense alcoholic beverages on Town Property as part of their Pearl River Day Festival to be held on Saturday, October 18, 2025, and

BE IT RESOLVED, that subject to the requirements of the New York State Liquor Authority regulations (SLA), including a securing a proper license therefrom, and the requirements of the Town of Orangetown Police Department, and to the execution of an agreement with the Town to provide indemnification and proof of insurance to the Town, and execution of an Agreement/Permit with respect to same, the Town Board hereby grants permission to the businesses authorized under the Pearl River Chamber of Commerce's permit to dispense alcoholic beverages upon Town property during the hours of 1 pm to 5 pm at the Pearl River Day Festival to be held on Saturday, October 18, 2025.

8. **ACCEPT WITH REGRET / RESIGNATION/RETIREMENT / KIMBERLY ALLEN / SUPERVISOR'S OFFICE / EFFECTIVE SEPTEMBER 30, 2025**

RESOLVED, that the Town Board hereby accepts with regret, the resignation/retirement of Kimberly Allen, in the Supervisor's office, after 35 years working for the Town of Orangetown, effective September 30, 2025.

9. **APPROVE THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE TOWN OF ORANGETOWN AND THE CIVIL SERVICE EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, INC. AFSCME, AFL-CIO FOR THE TOWN OF ORANGETOWN CSEA UNIT 8353, DATED JULY 31, 2025**

WHEREAS, the Collective Bargaining Agreement by and between the Town of Orangetown ("Town") and the Civil Service Employees Association, Inc. ("CSEA Unit 8353") was in effect from January 1, 2021 through and including December 31, 2024;

WHEREAS, the Town and CSEA Unit 8353 Negotiating Committees entered into negotiations concerning a new four (4) year agreement for the period beginning January 1, 2025 through and including December 31, 2028;

WHEREAS, the respective Town and CSEA Unit 8353 Negotiating Committees entered into a Memorandum of Agreement, dated July 31, 2025, for the purpose of recommending terms to the Town Board and CSEA constituencies for approval and ratification;

WHEREAS, the CSEA Unit 8353 ratified the July 31, 2025 Memorandum of Agreement on August 26, 2025, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town shall approve of the Memorandum of Agreement, dated July 31, 2025, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Supervisor or her designee is authorized to execute any and all legal documents in order to effectuate the enforcement of this resolution.

RESOLVED, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Highways, award the bid for One (1) New Street Sweeper to Trius Inc., Bohemia, NY, the only bidder, at a cost of \$361,980 to be charged to H.5130.200.24.

13. APPROVE FIRST AMENDMENT TO SRO AGREEMENT / PEARL RIVER SCHOOL DISTRICT / PROVIDE FOR TWO OFFICERS

WHEREAS, pursuant to Town Board Resolution No. 2023-320, the Pearl River School District (PRSD) and the Town entered into an Agreement dated June 14, 2023 whereby the Town Police Department would assign of a School Resource Officer (SRO) to the school district, wherein PRSD would reimburse the Town for a portion of the cost of such services and

WHEREAS, PRSD has requested that the Town assign a second SRO to the PRSD, under the same terms and conditions as the June 14, 2023 and with additional compensation for the second SRO,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board hereby authorizes the Town to amend the existing Agreement dated June 14, 2023 by executing a First Amendment to Agreement, which First Amendment has been prepared, reviewed and approved by the Town Attorney's Office, whereby the Town agrees to assign two SROs to the PRSD on a yearly basis commencing with the 20225/26 school year, for a three (3) year period, under the terms and conditions as set forth in the First Amendment, and the PRSD shall reimburse the Town in accordance with the terms of the First Amendment and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Board hereby authorizes the Supervisor or her designee to execute the agreements with each district under the terms and conditions as set forth therein on behalf of the Town of Orangetown and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Town Board hereby authorizes the Chief of Police to execute the agreement with PRSD on behalf of the Police Department and to administer same on behalf of the Town and the Town Police Department.

RESOLVED, upon the recommendation from the Superintendent of Highways & Chief of Police, that the Town Board hereby authorizes these departments to lend assistance which includes the use of barricades & trash bins from the Highway Dept., and auxiliary police from OPD, for the OFD annual holiday parade to be held on Saturday, December 13, 2025 (rain date: Sunday, December 14, 2025), on various roads in the hamlet of Orangeburg, from 6 pm – 10 pm.
