The review undertaken by the Rockland County Planning Department is pursuant to, and follows the mandates of Article 12-B of the New York General Municipal Law. Under Article 12-B the County of Rockland does not render opinions, nor does it make determinations, whether the item reviewed implicates the Religious Land Use and Institutionalized Persons Act. The Rockland County Planning Department defers to the municipality forwarding the item reviewed to render such opinions and make such determinations if appropriate under the circumstances.

In this respect, municipalities are advised that under the Religious Land Use and Institutionalized Persons Act, the preemptive force of any provision of the Act may be avoided (1) by changing a policy or practice that may result in a substantial burden on religious exercise, (2) by retaining a policy or practice and exempting the substantially burdened religious exercise, (3) by providing exemptions from a policy or practice for applications that substantially burden religious exercise, or (4) by any other means that eliminates the substantial burden.

Proponents of projects are advised to apply for variances, special permits or exceptions, hardship approval or other relief.

Pursuant to New York State General Municipal Law §239-m(6), the referring body shall file a report of final action it has taken with the Rockland County Department of Planning within thirty (30) days after final action. A referring body which acts contrary to a recommendation of modification or disapproval of a proposed action shall set forth the reasons for the contrary action in such report.

Dear Ms. Arbolino:

We have received an application and for the above referenced project. Comments are as follows:

- 1. Our records indicate that there is a septic system on the property, in the immediate vicinity of the proposed pool. It is to be verified that the dwelling is connected to the sanitary line in the driveway before permits are issued. The existing septic system is to be properly decommissioned, including removal of the field, before a swimming pool and associated equipment is installed.
- 2. Should the Board require a stormwater management system to remediate the increase in impervious surface, application is to be made to the RCDOH for review of the system for compliance with the County Mosquito Code.
