Trish Moran, Pearl River, suggested that town officers take lower raises.

A discussion took place between the Town Board members. Charles Richardson, Director of Finance explained why it is not wise for the Town to "Bond" for the mandated pension contribution increases. Health insurance is expected to rise 18.6%. After a continued discussion the Town Board rejected its 2004 preliminary budget but agreed to review the increases.




