Town of Orangetown Veteran's Road Dedication

This Street is dedicated to Water Tender First Class, Ogden W. Rowan (born November 11th, 1917 – died May 28th, 1945) who served in the United States Navy. W.T.F.C. Rowan was killed in action aboard the U.S.S. Drexler as two twin-engine kamikaze airplanes crashed into the warship. While repairing damage caused by the first strike, the second plane struck that repair location and W.T.F.C. Rowan perished in service to our country off the coast of Okinawa, Japan.
